### Recommendations

#### That Council:

- 1. Give three readings to the proposed Bylaw, as set out in Attachment 1, to amend Bylaw 35M2018; and
- 2. Give three readings to the proposed Bylaw, as set out in Attachment 2, to amend Bylaw 29M2007.



### **Proposed Bylaw Amendments**

#### **Election Bylaw (Bylaw 35M2018)**

- Administrative amendments:
  - Alignment with current legislation.
  - Capture the legal name change: Calgary Roman Catholic Separate School Division.
  - Updated definitions.
- Reflects accountability for the Alberta Senate election and provinciallydirected referendum questions.



### **Proposed Bylaw Amendments**

#### Election Bylaw (Bylaw 35M2018)

- Captures existing ballot procedures to enhance transparency:
  - Defective (or damaged) ballots,
  - Ballots with marks which are unreadable by the vote tabulator,
  - Blank ballots,
  - Ballots with more marks than permitted in an election, and
  - Ballots with missing deputy returning officer initials.



## **Proposed Bylaw Amendments**

#### Early voting hours bylaw (Bylaw 29M2007)

- Elections Calgary is accountable for administering the separate school board elections.
- This jurisdiction includes Airdrie, Calgary, Chestermere and Cochrane.
- Bylaw 29M2007 permits early voting hours for separate school voters in Airdrie and Cochrane.
- Proposed amendment permits separate school voters in Chestermere to vote at 8 a.m. on Election Day, consistent with the municipality's voting hours.
- Bylaw amendment is required to be passed by 2021 June 30.
