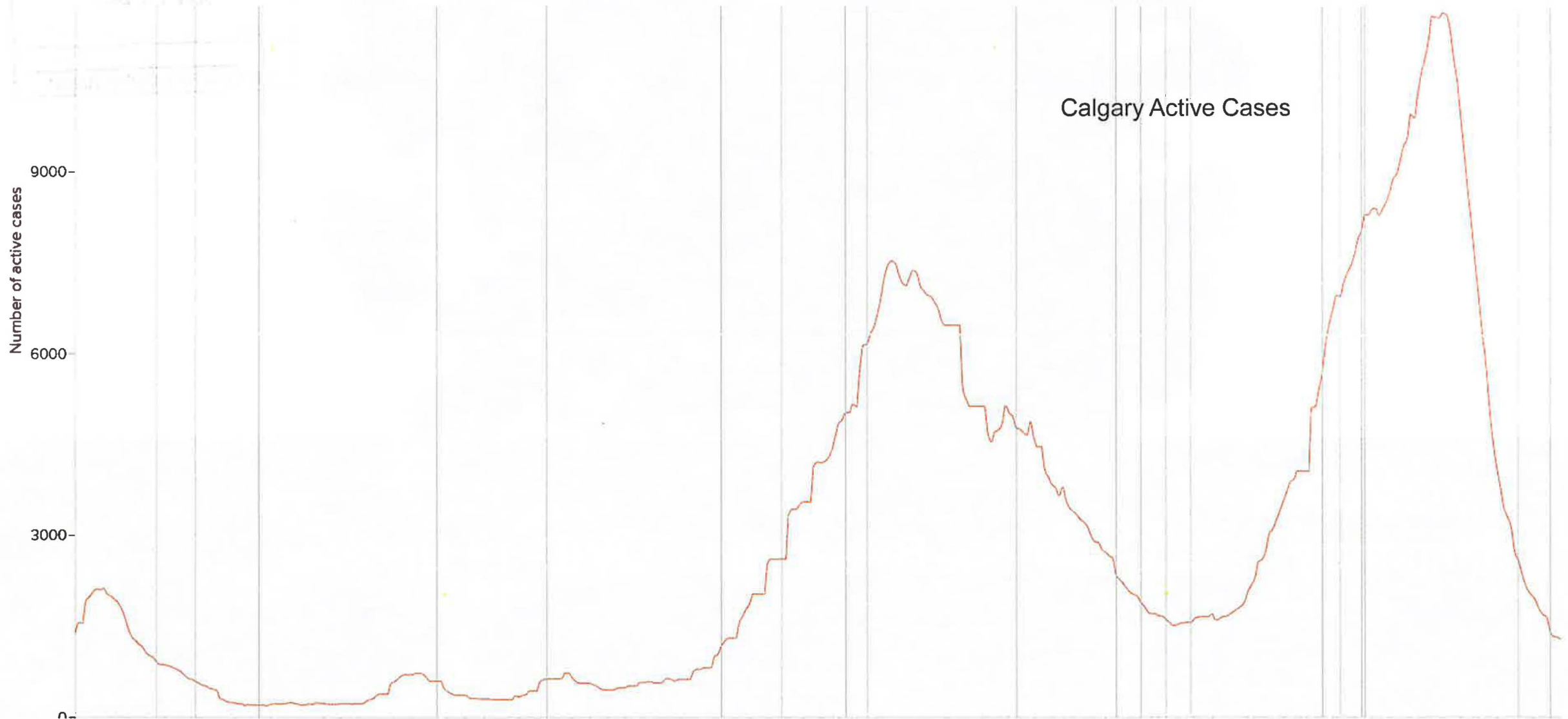

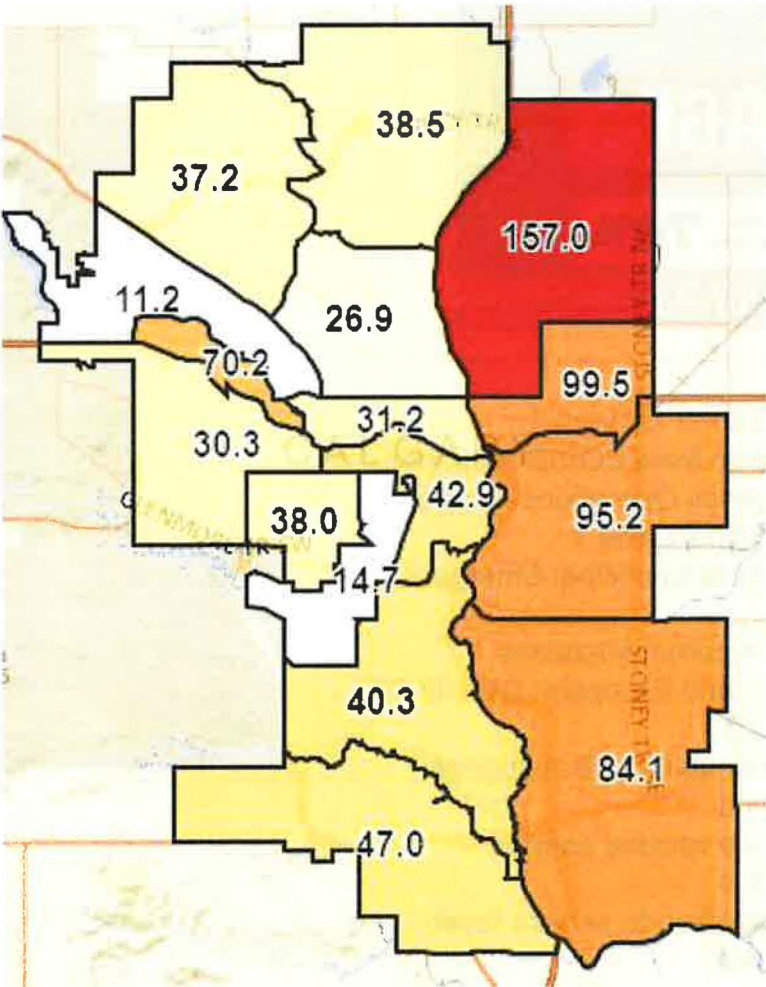
Current Situation – Decreasing Cases



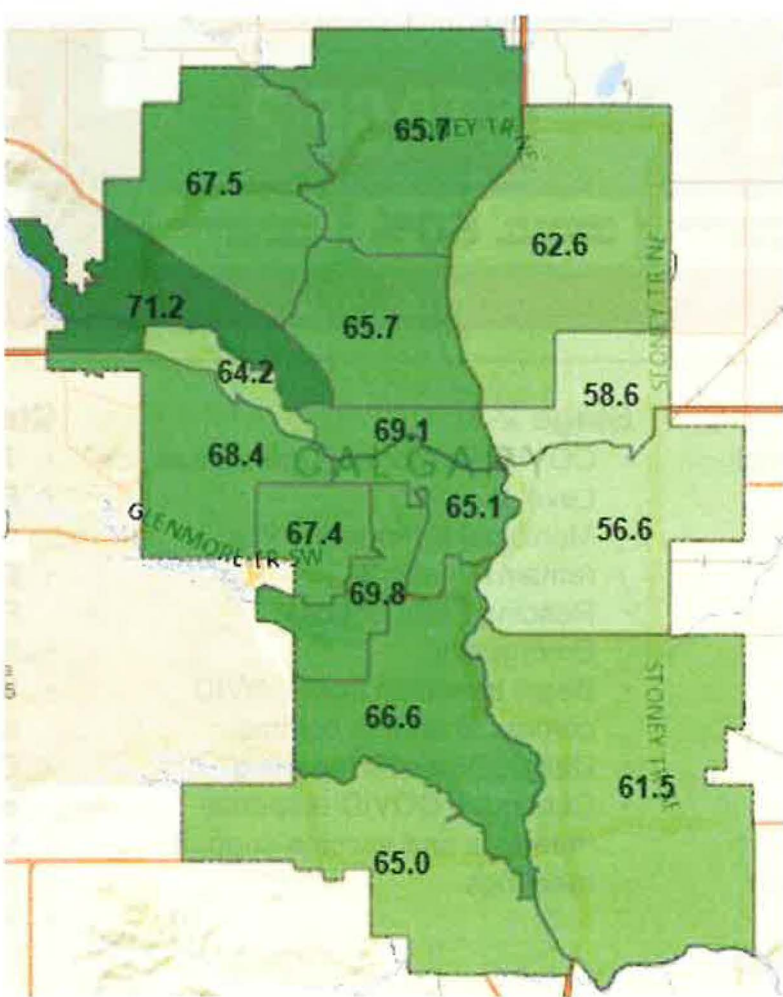

Current Situation – Increasing Vaccinations

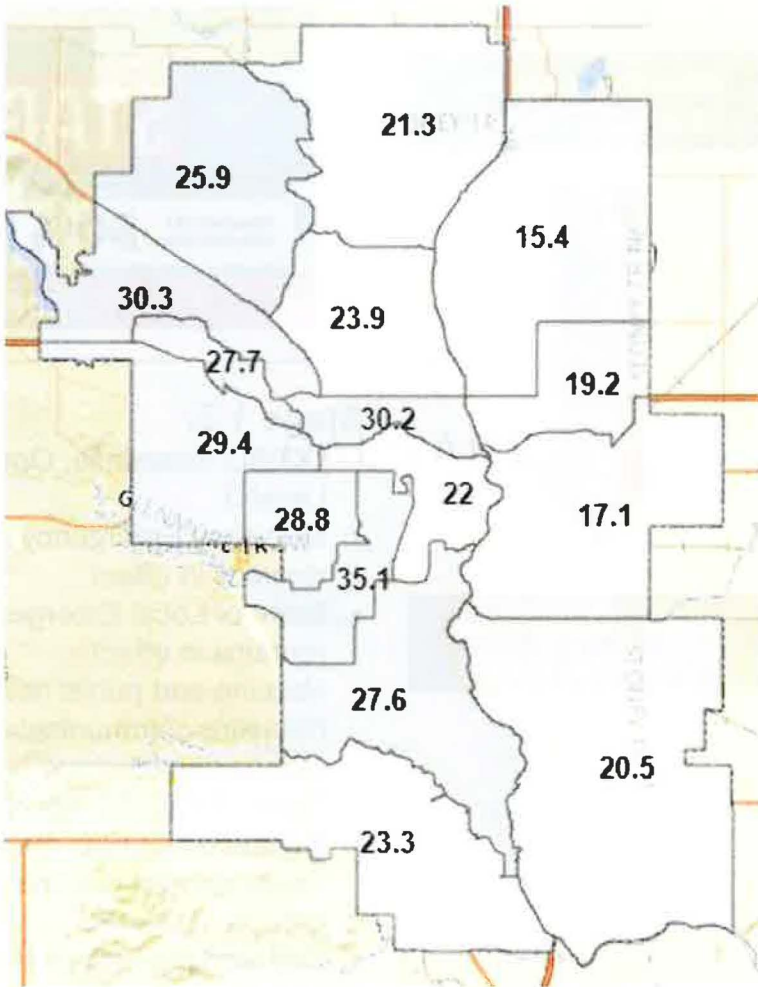
Active Cases/100k Population

Calgary Response Transition

Alberta Open for Summer Stage



Calgary Response Transition Stage



Stage 1-2:

- COVID Response: Operational Level 3
- Municipal Emergency Plan remains in effect
- State of Local Emergency remains in effect.
- Vaccine and public health measure communications campaigns continue
- Daily COVID-19 reporting
- Continued COVID response meetings and vaccine support groups
- City working groups to manage transition and reopening strategies

Stage 2-3:

- COVID Response: Operational Level 2
- Municipal Emergency Plan remains in effect
- Rescind State of Local Emergency
- Begin transition from COVID comms to routine comms
- Daily COVID-19 reporting
- Continued COVID response meetings and vaccine support meetings

Stage 3 and Beyond:

- Transition from COVID response
- Emergency Operations Centre: Operational Level 1
- Deactivate Municipal Emergency Plan
- Routine communications
- Weekly and Exception COVID-19 reporting
- Discontinue COVID response meetings
- Continue vaccine support meetings
- Full transition to service-level decisions

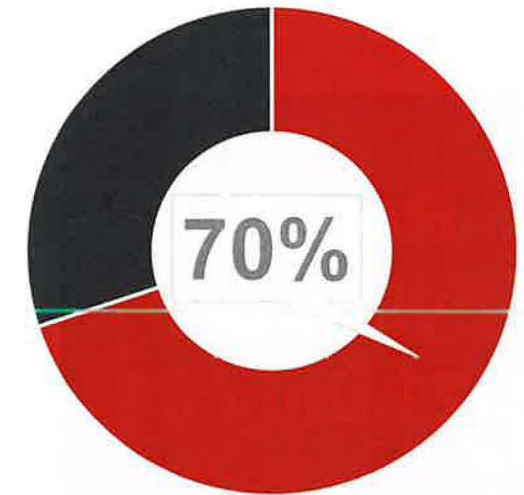

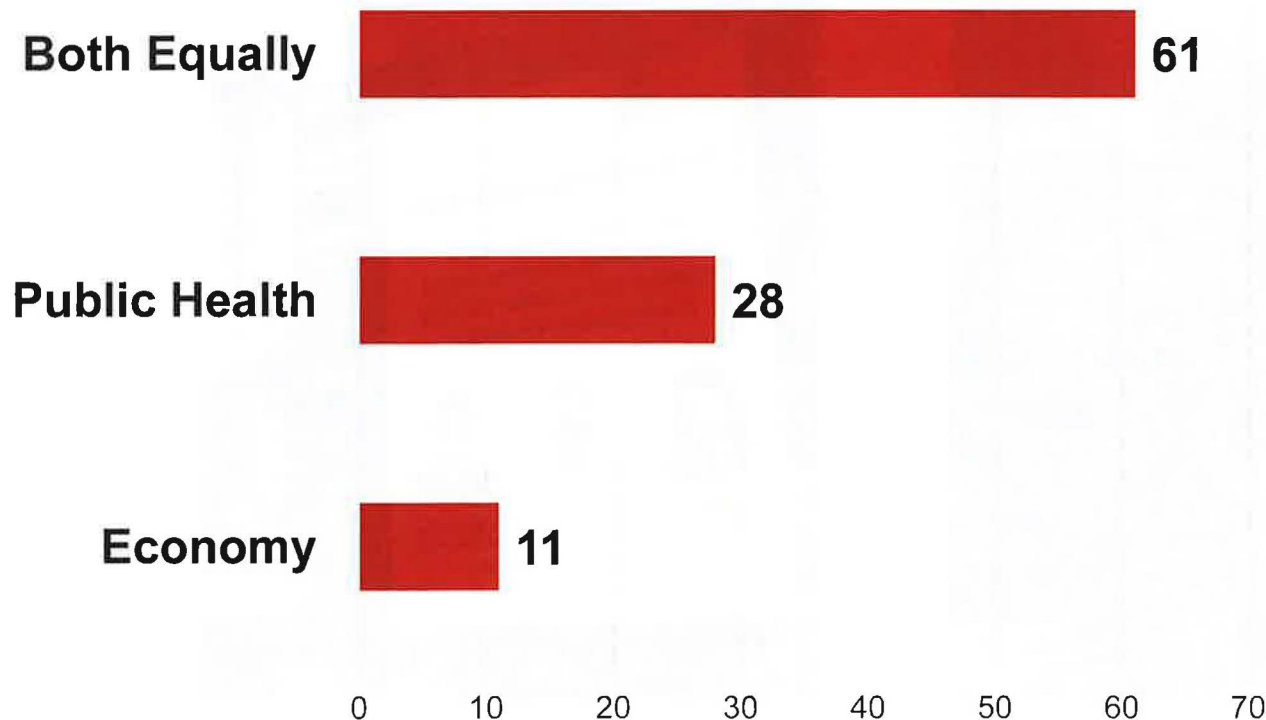

RECOMMENDATION:

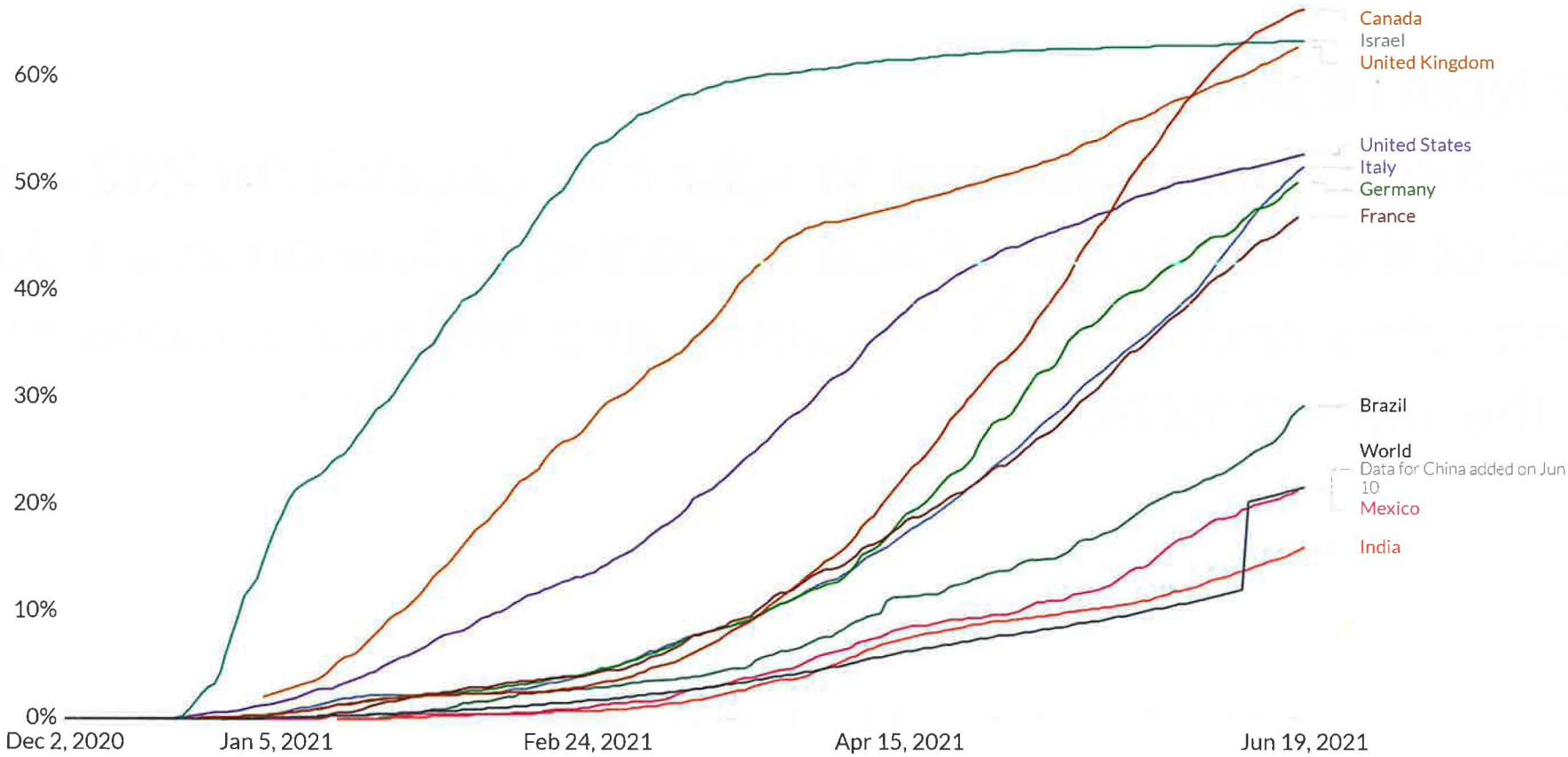
That Council direct Administration to return to Council on 2021 July 26 with a repeal of the Temporary Face Covering Bylaw on 2021 July 31 if vaccination rates and COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations are trending in the right direction.

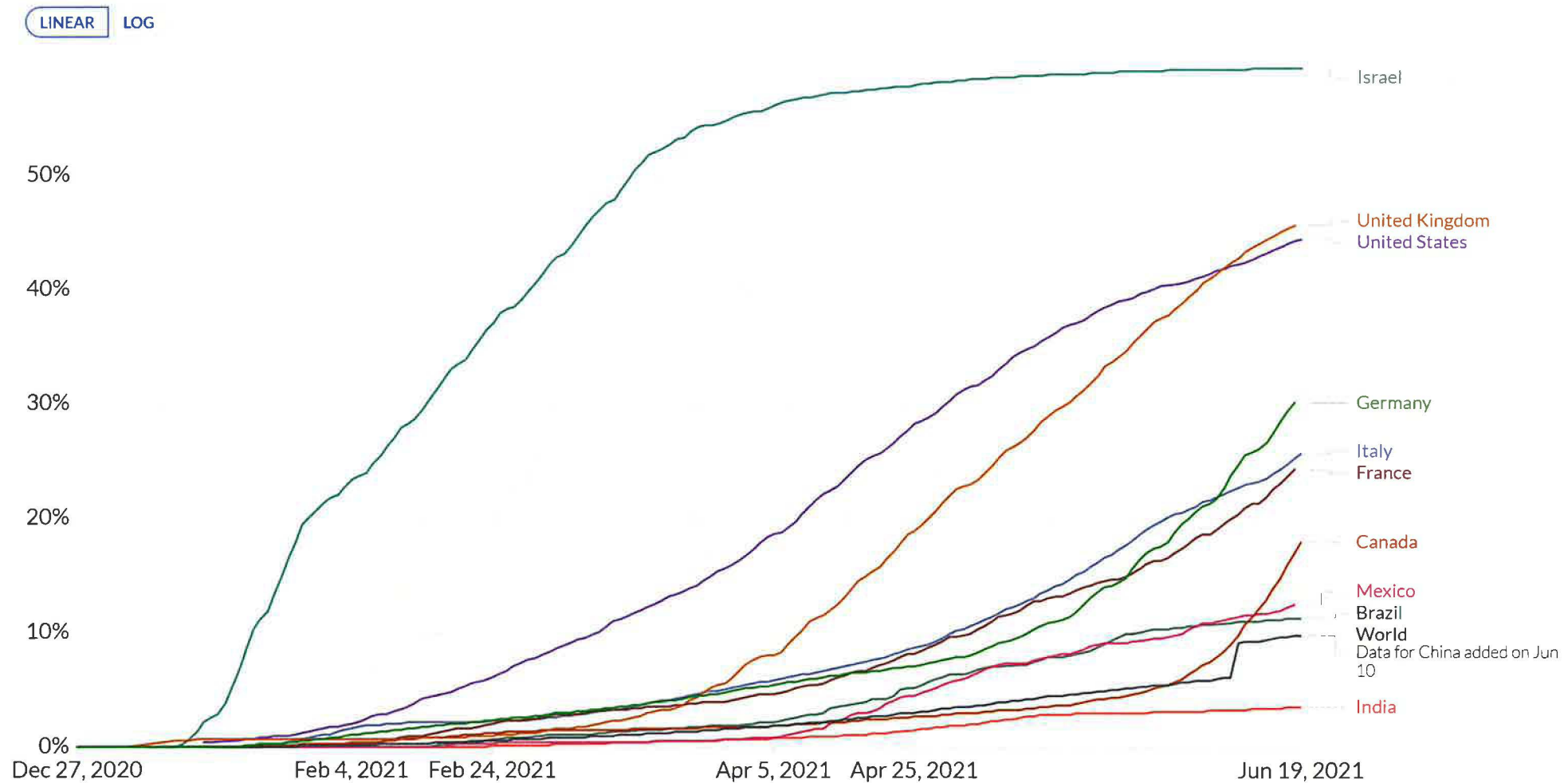
