


Current Situation – Decreasing Cases






Calgary Current Situation – Increasing Vaccinations


Active Cases/100k Population

Calgary Response Transition



Calgary Response Transition Stage

Stage 1-2:

- · COVID Response: Operational Level 3
- · Municipal Emergency Plan remains in effect
- · State of Local Emergency remains in effect.
- Vaccine and public health measure communications campaigns continue
- Daily COVID-19 reporting
- Continued COVID response meetings and vaccine support groups
- · City working groups to manage transition and reopening strategies

Stage 2-3:

· COVID Response: Operational Level 2

Hospitalizations

- · Municipal Emergency Plan remains in effect
- · Rescind State of Local Emergency
- · Begin transition from COVID comms to routine comms
- Daily COVID-19 reporting
- · Continued COVID response meetings and vaccine support meetings

Stage 3 and Beyond:

Albertans 12+ with first dose 70%

Early-July

- · Transition from COVID response
- · Emergency Operations Centre: Operational Level 1
- Deactivate Municipal Emergency Plan
- Routine communications
- Weekly and Exception COVID-19 reporting
- Discontinue COVID response meetings
- · Continue vaccine support meetings
- · Full transition to service-level decisions

Repeal in Phase 3 of Open for Summer

Repeal when 75% of Calgarians are fully vaccinated

Option 3


Repeal in December (status quo)












What We Do Know





RECOMMENDATION:


That Council direct Administration to return to Council on 2021 July 26 with a repeal of the Temporary Face Covering Bylaw on 2021 July 31 if vaccination rates and COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations are trending in the right direction.

Share of the total population that received at least one vaccine dose. This may not equal the share that are fully vaccinated if the vaccine requires two doses.






Share of the population fully vaccinated against COVID-19
