- VIII.Landowner application notification/authorization



Process Change Medium Term

- I. Track change of use application paths
 - i. Streamline process
 - ii. Circulations keep? shorten? eliminate?
 - iii. DP exempt permitted uses?
 - iv. Discretionary use to permitted use?
 - v. Better alignment for change of use, business license, and building permit
- II. More flexibility for initial DP use approval
- III. Reduce fees or continue fee relief
