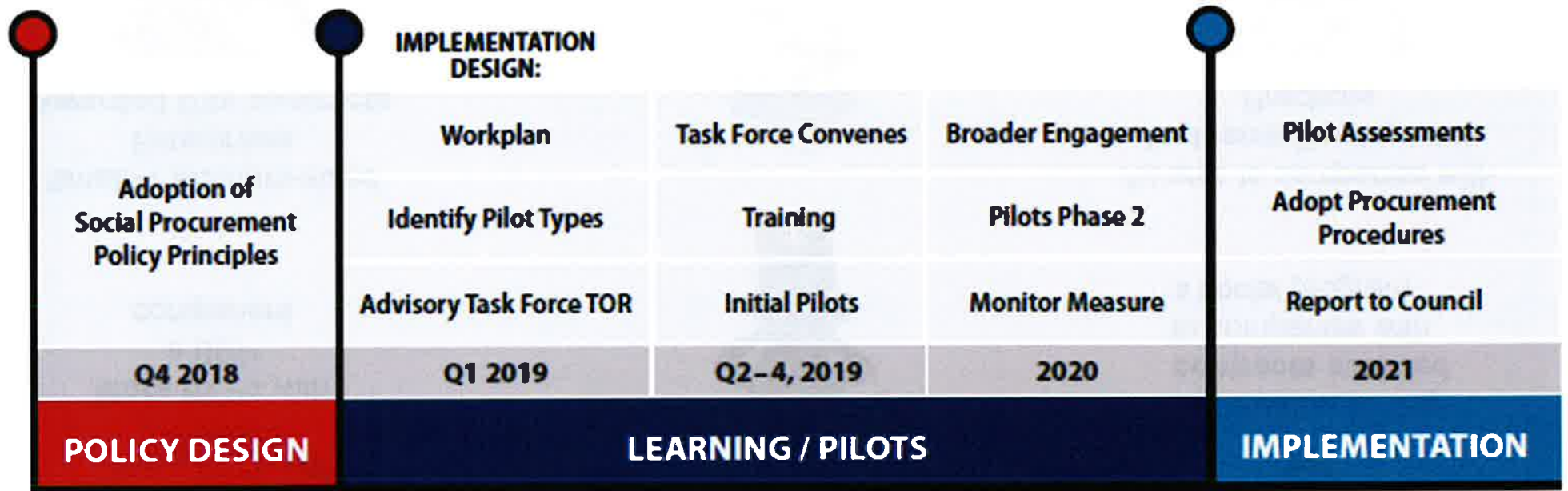


Recommendations

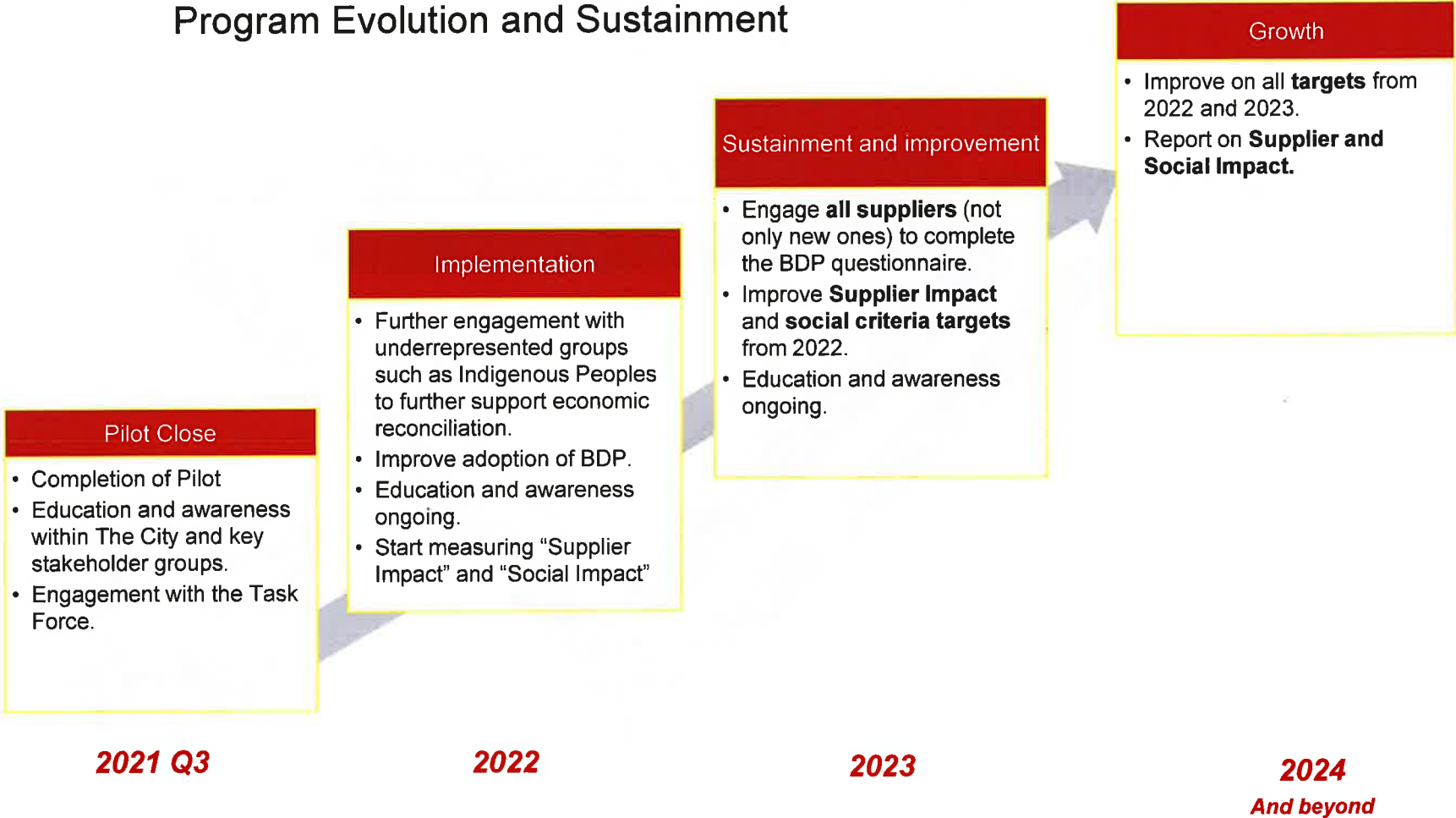

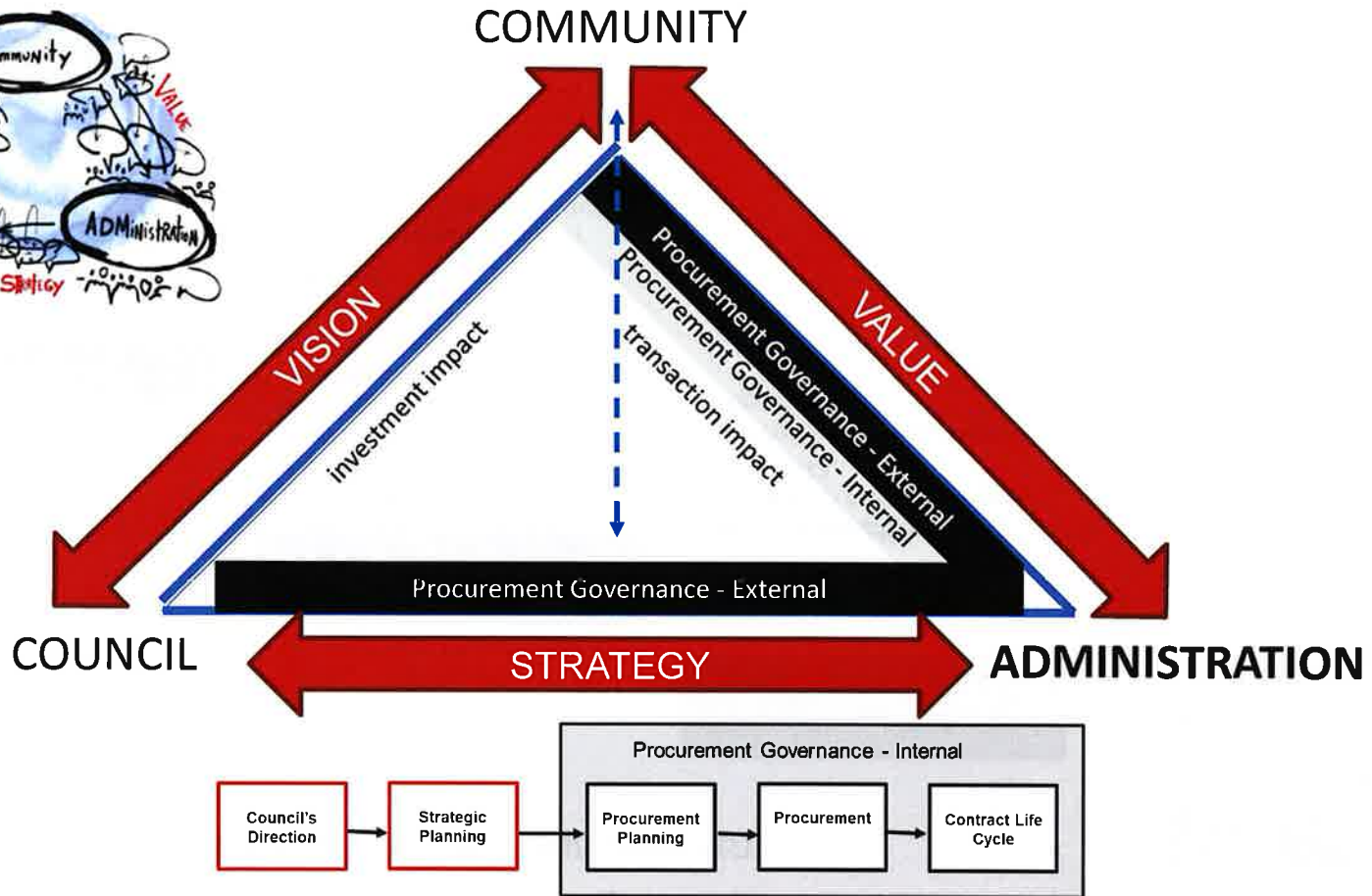


BDP - where is it going?

Pillars of Public Value through Procurement

All procurement creates public value including by:

COMMUNITY – COUNCIL - vision

- ***Intentional investment*** through procurement activities in economic, socio-cultural, and environmental outcomes valued by residents and businesses in Calgary;

COUNCIL – ADMINISTRATION – strategy

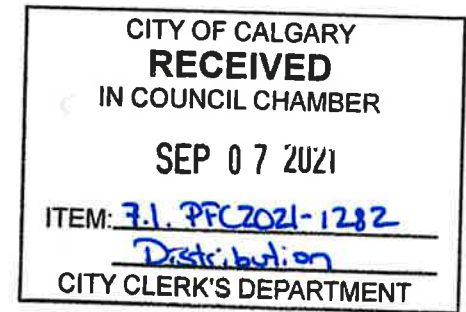
- ***Intentional and strategic procurement planning*** through collaborative conversation across the community to inform procurement decision-making; and
- ***Intentional procurement decision-making*** in accordance with public procurement law during the program and project procurement planning.

ADMINISTRATION – COMMUNITY – value

- Intentional public value is optimized through the procurement strategy & through the execution of contract to support The City's services.



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
