**RE: The Future of Transportation in Calgary**

**COUNCILLOR EVAN WOOLLEY, PETER DEMONG**

WHEREAS rapid advancements in transportation technologies have the potential to transform the transportation network;

AND WHEREAS the development of autonomous vehicles and other technologies have the potential to significantly change how the transportation network is designed and used;

AND WHEREAS societal and generational trends are significantly evolving and people are using diverse approaches towards getting around;

AND WHEREAS in planning for a multi-modal transportation network we need to ensure our planning and infrastructure decisions meet both short and long term needs and are fiscally responsible.

AND WHEREAS The City should be proactive, rather than reactive, in responding to new technologies.

AND WHEREAS the Calgary Transportation Plan, adopted by Council in 2009, contemplates some but not all of these advancements;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Council direct Administration to undertake a study on societal trends and advancements in transportation technologies as they relate to Calgary with the potential to significantly transform our transportation network, such as;

- Autonomous vehicles
- Alternate delivery methods (e.g. drones)
- Alternate vehicle fuels and electrical charging systems
- Connected vehicles
- Alternate public transit provisions
- Alternate parking and curbside management strategies
- Open data and development of apps
- Alternate payment mechanisms

And report back to Council through the Transportation and Transit Committee with recommendations, potential pilot opportunities and next steps, no later than Q1 2017.
