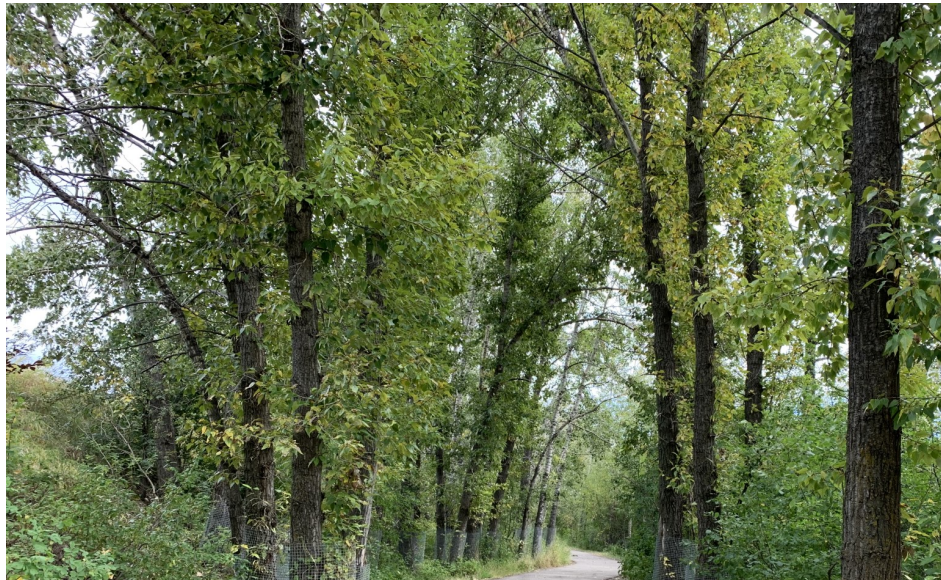

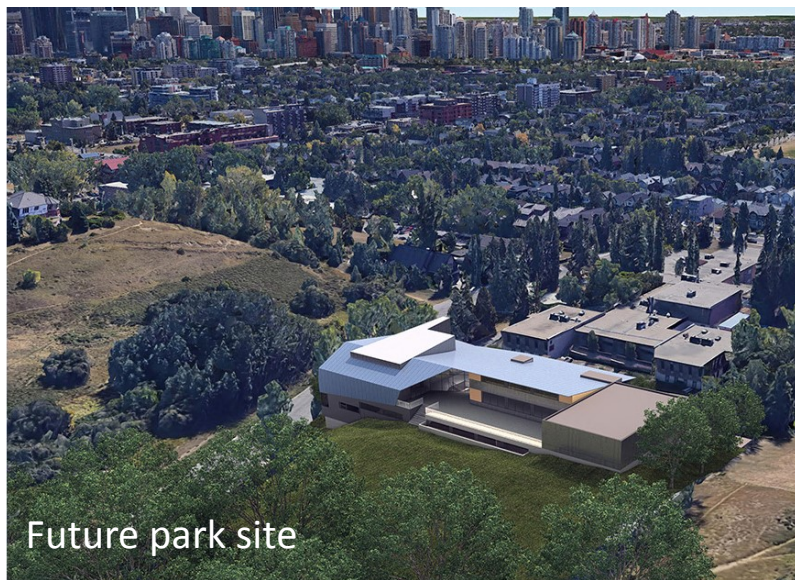

Trees Line Sides, Creating Sense of Entry

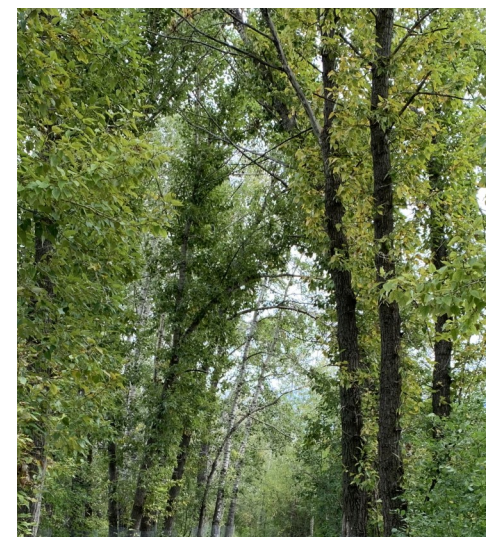
Elevation View
