**Council Members** 

We have worked on this project for many years and have finally managed to get to this accommodation by both the Community and the Applicant.

We approve the Land Use Re designation to MC1 and will be watching with interest for the Development Permit application when we will actually be able to assess the impact on our Community.

To that end however, we have one request of Council. We ask that this change be given 1st Reading only and that 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading be withheld until the DP application goes back to CPC and ourselves for our input.

Our reason for asking for this is that we are afraid that having got the change of land use the applicant may sell the land and then we could have a much denser building than he has promised.

Also in the notes of the CPC meeting the following suggestion was made by Ms. Wade with which we concur:

1. from Ms. Wade: • Support the land use but suggest the development permit run concurrently with the land use to ensure that the community and the City have greater assurance of the built form. Particularly in neighbourhoods that are intensifying. Perhaps this could be considered at Council?
