


Taxi Limousine Advisory Committee



Mandate: To provide advice and recommendations to Council to ensure high quality taxi and limousine services and 'to create and maintain a sustainable ... industry' as specified in Bylaw 6M2007. The objective is to ensure public safety, service quality and consumer protection for customers and service providers. The TLAC will follow the direction of Council by responding to Council requests and making recommendations to City Council.

- Composition: 1 Representative for taxi brokers, who holds a Brokerage Licence in good standing with Livery Transport Services
 - 1 Representative for limousine brokers, who holds a Brokerage Licence in good standing with Livery Transport Services
 - 2 Representatives for taxi and limousine drivers who holds a Taxi Drivers Licence or Limousine Drivers Licence in good standing with Livery Transport Services and do not hold a Brokerage Licence
 - 1 Representative, nominated by Calgary Airport Authority
 - 1 Representative, nominated by Tourism Calgary
 - 1 Representative, nominated by Calgary Hotel Association
 - 1 Representative from Calgary Police Service (non-voting)
 - 1 Representative from Transportation Planning (non-voting)
 - 1 Representative from Livery Transportation Services (non-voting)
 - 5 Representatives of the general public, selected by Council from respondents to a public notice
 - 1 Representative of the Advisory Committee on Accessibility

The Chair of TLAC is appointed by Council from the five (5) representatives of the general public.

Voting Members shall:

- Represent one of the categories identified by Council
- Be at least 18 yrs of age
- Be a resident of The City of Calgary
- Not be a member of the Licence and Community Standards Appeal Board or the City of Calgary Administration
- Abide by pecuniary interest requirements

Non-Voting Members:

- Represent one of the categories identified by Council,
- Be at least 18 yrs of age
- Not vote on motions before TLAC,
- Not be a member of the Licence and Community Standards Appeal Board,
- Abide by pecuniary interest requirements

The following skills & experience are an asset:

- 3 to 5 yrs experience as a board member
- Conflict resolution training or experience
- Policy & public administration knowledge

- Budget planning & financial management experience

- Research & analysis experience

- Good verbal & written communication skills

Term: Each member is appointed for a 2 year term, effective the date of the annual Organizational Meeting of Council, with a maximum of 2 consecutive terms. To ensure business continuity, appointments will be staggered by appointing up to five members annually. A member may resign at any time upon written notice to City Council, and Council may, by resolution, remove any member.
