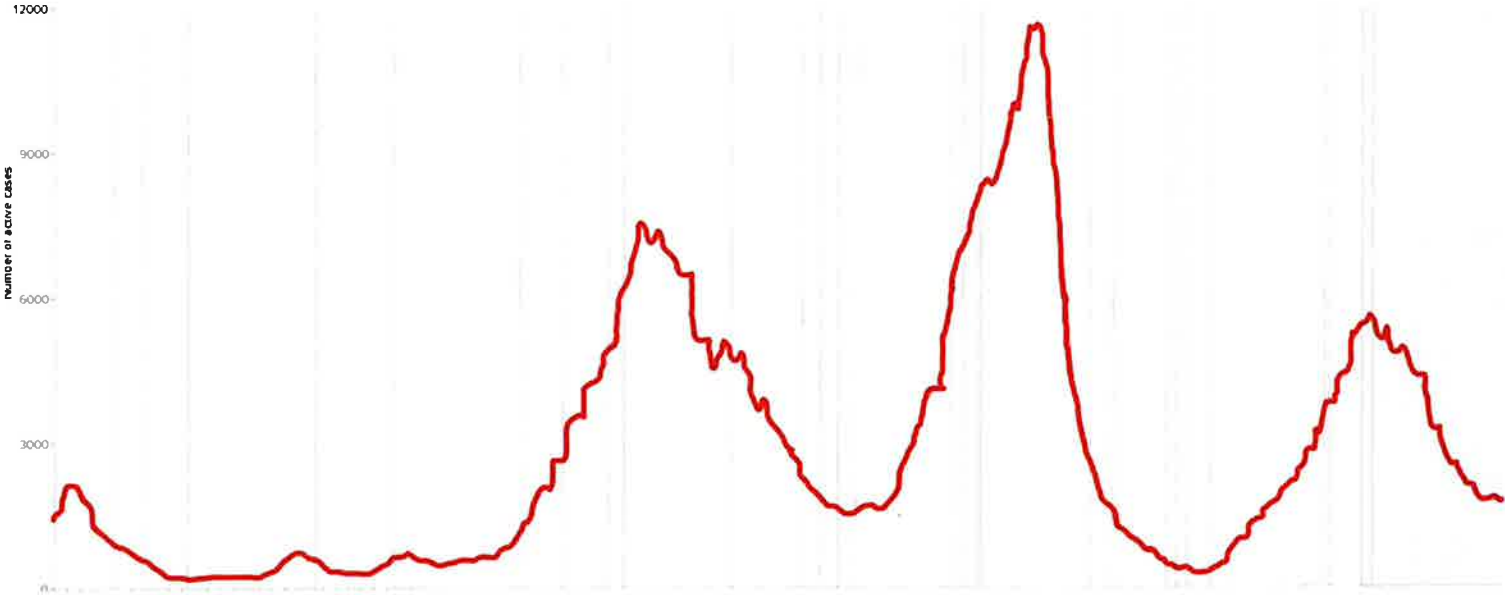

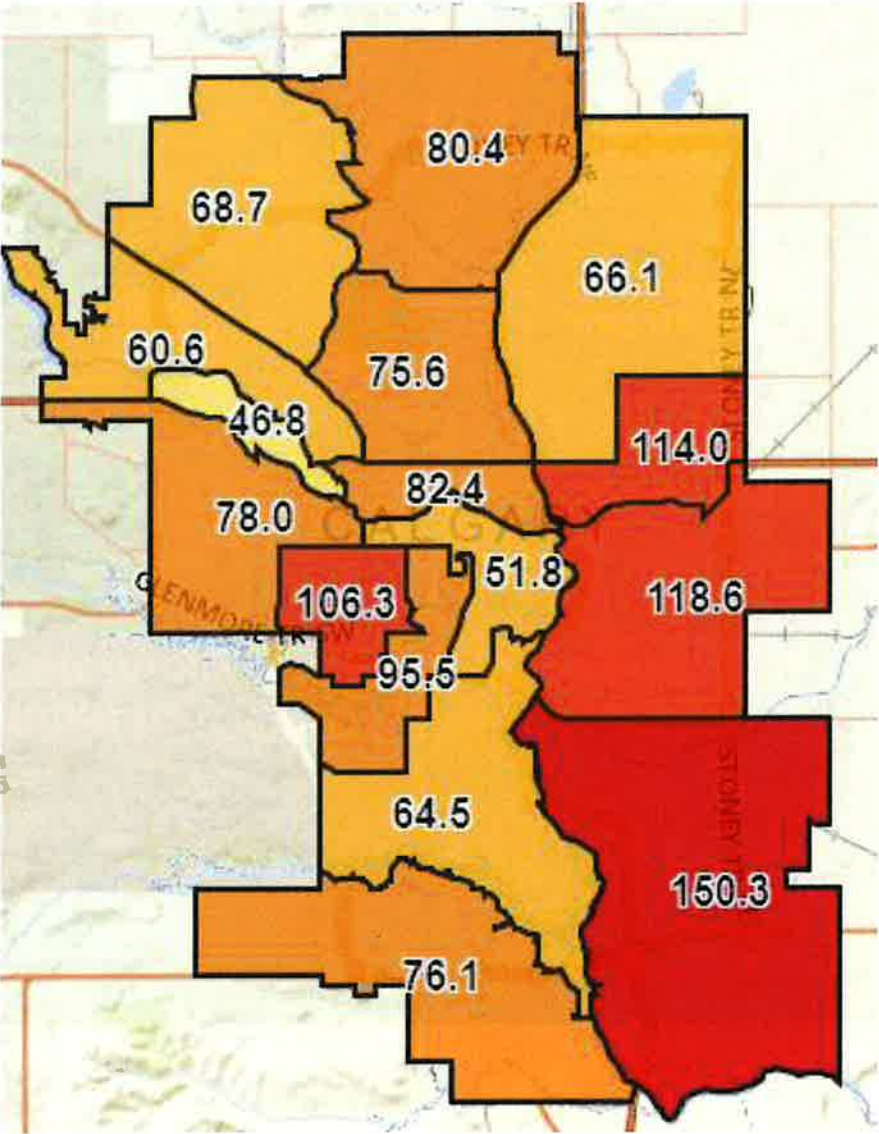

Active Cases, Calgary Zone: 1,734

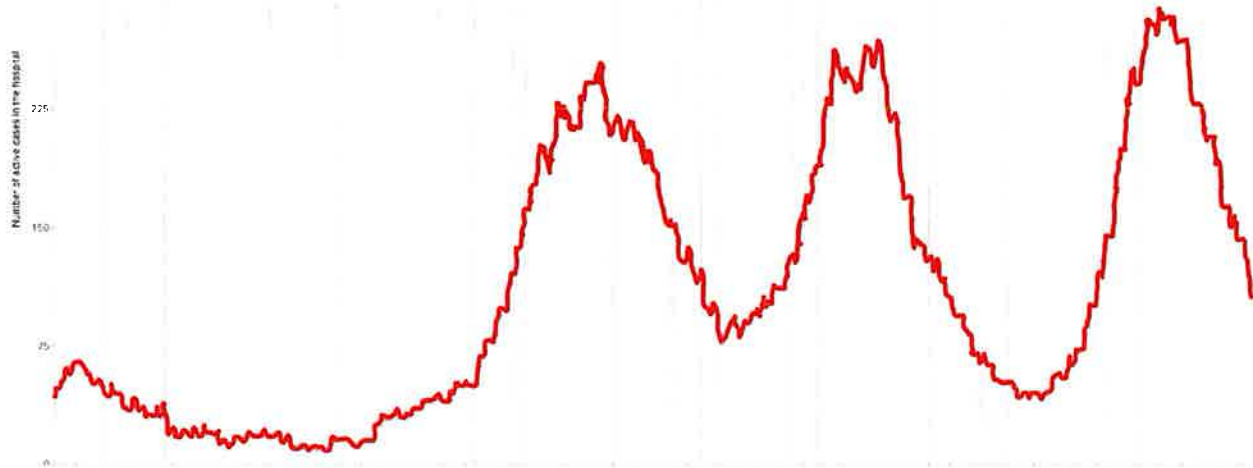


**Regional Indicator:
83.8 Cases/100k Population**

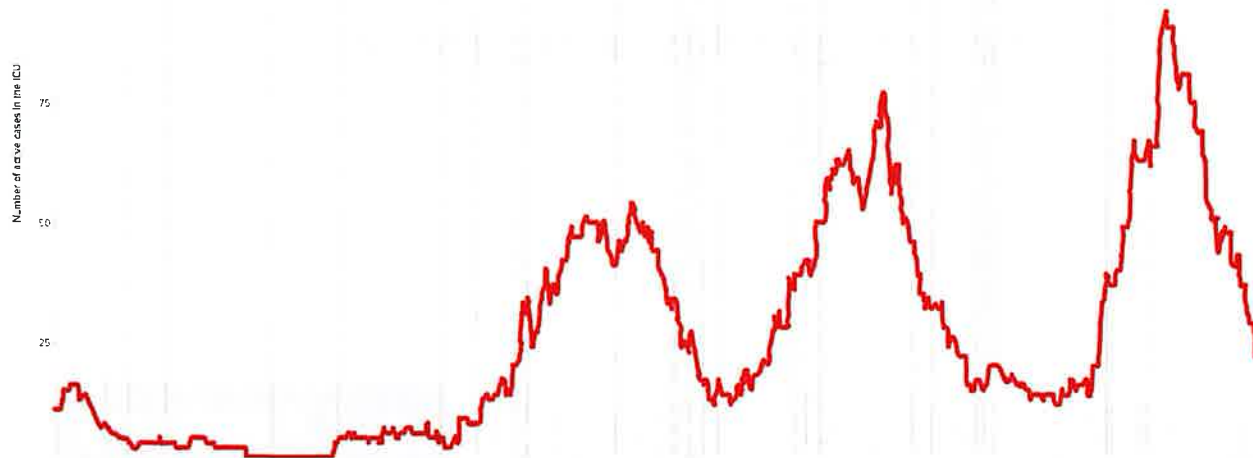


COVID Update: Severe Outcomes

Hospitalizations, Calgary Zone: 105



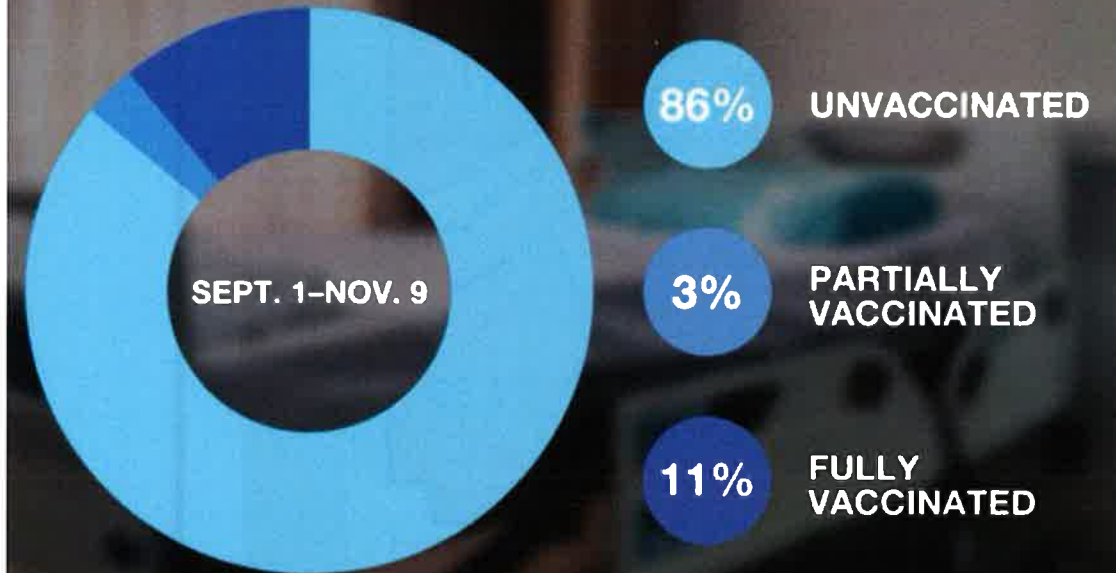
ICU Admissions, Calgary Zone: 22

Calgary REP Business Support Grant



- Launched on October 12, 2021, this grant provides \$2,000 to any business that is required to participate in the Restrictions Exemption Program under Bylaw 65M2021. The grant program will run until November 30 or until funds run out.
- As of November 8, 2021, we had received 3,304 applications and provisionally approved 1,588 applications for total support of ~\$3.2M
- There is just over \$5M available to fund the Business Support Grant.
- This is in addition to any provincial funding that may be coming.

Restriction Exemption Program

In Scope

Restaurants, bars, pubs, patios, food courts
 Nightclubs
 Casinos, bingo Halls, VLT Lounges
 Entertainment and recreation centres: bowling, racing entertainment, arcades, billiards halls, other similar
 Museums, art galleries
 Movie theatres
 Conferences, meeting spaces, halls, and rented spaces
 Weddings and funerals held in public facilities
 Professional sporting or other performance events (spectators)
 Private social events held in public facilities
 Recreation and fitness facilities
 Adult recreational sport groups (players/participants)
 Recreation classes and activities
 Amenities in hotels/condos (pools, gyms etc)

Out of Scope

Events in private dwellings
 Retail and shopping malls
 Libraries
 Workers and employees in/on a worksite for employment
 Schools (Kindergarten to Grade 12)
 School curriculum-based activities
 Accommodations (e.g., hotel rooms)
 Places of Worship – for faith services
 Health Services
 Personal Services
 Wellness Services
 Publicly-funded post secondary institutions, including cafeterias and residence common areas
 First Nations College entities
