- Enabling bylaw

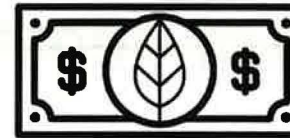


What are we trying to accomplish?

Why the Clean Energy Improvement Program?

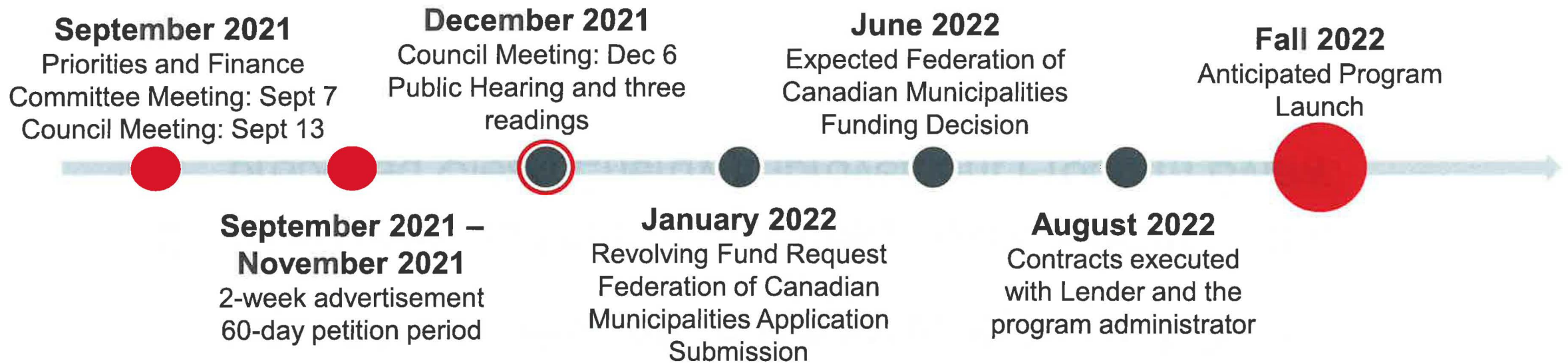
- Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) **programs are successful** in other jurisdictions
- Program is **already designed** by the Alberta Municipal Services Corporation
- **Federal funding available**
- **Creates foundation** of low carbon financing programs in Calgary



Clean Energy Improvement Program Bylaw

1. Establishes program and enables property tax repayment mechanism
2. Enables The City to borrow to finance clean energy improvements
 - a) \$10 Million loan and \$5 Million grant
 - b) \$5 Million revolving fund
3. Establishes minimum criteria for property, participant, and project eligibility
 - a) Developing detailed program design and delivery processes
