RE: Residential Traffic Safety Enforcement

COUNCILLOR SHANE KEATING

WHEREAS Residential traffic safety represents a growing concern on the part of Calgary communities;

AND WHEREAS the Calgary Police Service (CPS) is committed to enhancing traffic safety through the reduction of collisions involving vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists;

AND WHEREAS while progress has been made to address traffic safety, with key CPS initiatives such as the Traffic Safety Request process, and the collaborative multi-agency Safer Mobility Team, a commitment to continual improvement is crucial;

AND WHEREAS CPS, in conjunction with its City and community partners, is exploring a dedicated residential traffic enforcement team framework;

AND WHEREAS this team would focus on enhancing public safety through an emphasis on:

- targeting high risk residential areas such as school and playground zones along with other pedestrian rich locations;
- utilizing citizen feedback through the Traffic Safety Request system to inform operational response;
- emphasizing proactive public education to enhance public awareness; and
- sharing traffic enforcement data with City partners to support further intervention approaches when needed, including traffic calming measures.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that CPS be directed to develop a residential traffic enforcement team framework, in conjunction with its key City and community stakeholders. Reporting back to the Standing Policy Committee on Community & Protective Services with the team framework and associated financial implications by no later than 2016 November.
