Initial concept was discussed with the neighboring business in 2018 when a development was first contemplated. The project was postponed due to business requirements and recommenced in 2020 for project development planning and approval applications. As Calgary Aggregate Recycling (CAR) has been operating continuously during this time, informal dialogue with the neighbor businesses continued.

In 2018, during the exploration of the concept, a meeting was held with Ward 12 Councillor Shane Keating to introduce the development plan concept.
