Date: July 28, 2021. Location: Neighbors of my house I spoke to the neighbours within a one block radius and applied a Google map pin to the search engine for the daycare location. A total of twenty families contacted me and inquired as what I was offering for Child Care. The majority of the twenty families were from within my area within a ten block radius. The overview of this strategy addresses the positive impact and to become aware of any concerns or negative reactions of having the child care at this location. As there have been no significant negative responses other than having signs on the front lawn as the direct neighbour has expressed concern for property values. This only was brought to my attention after I did not wish to replace the shared fencing of length eight feet. I suspect the neighbour is upset. I will continue to remain in contact with them to alleviate any concerns or find eventual solutions.
