

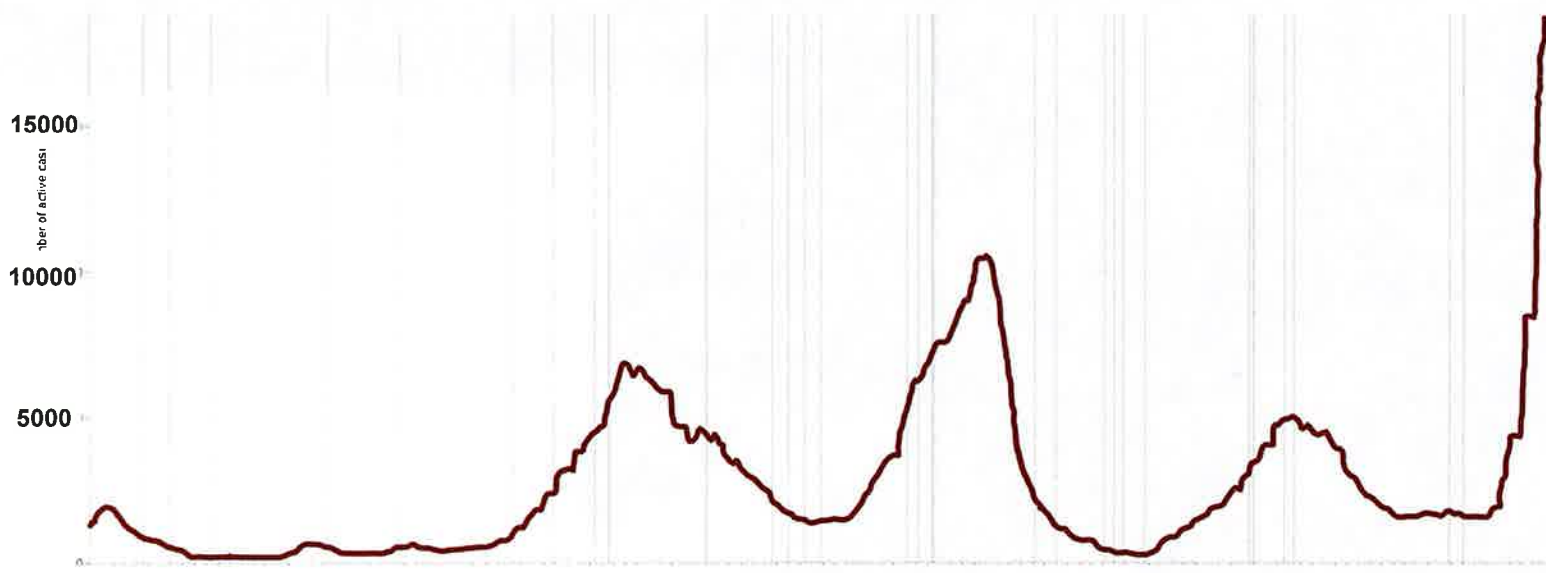

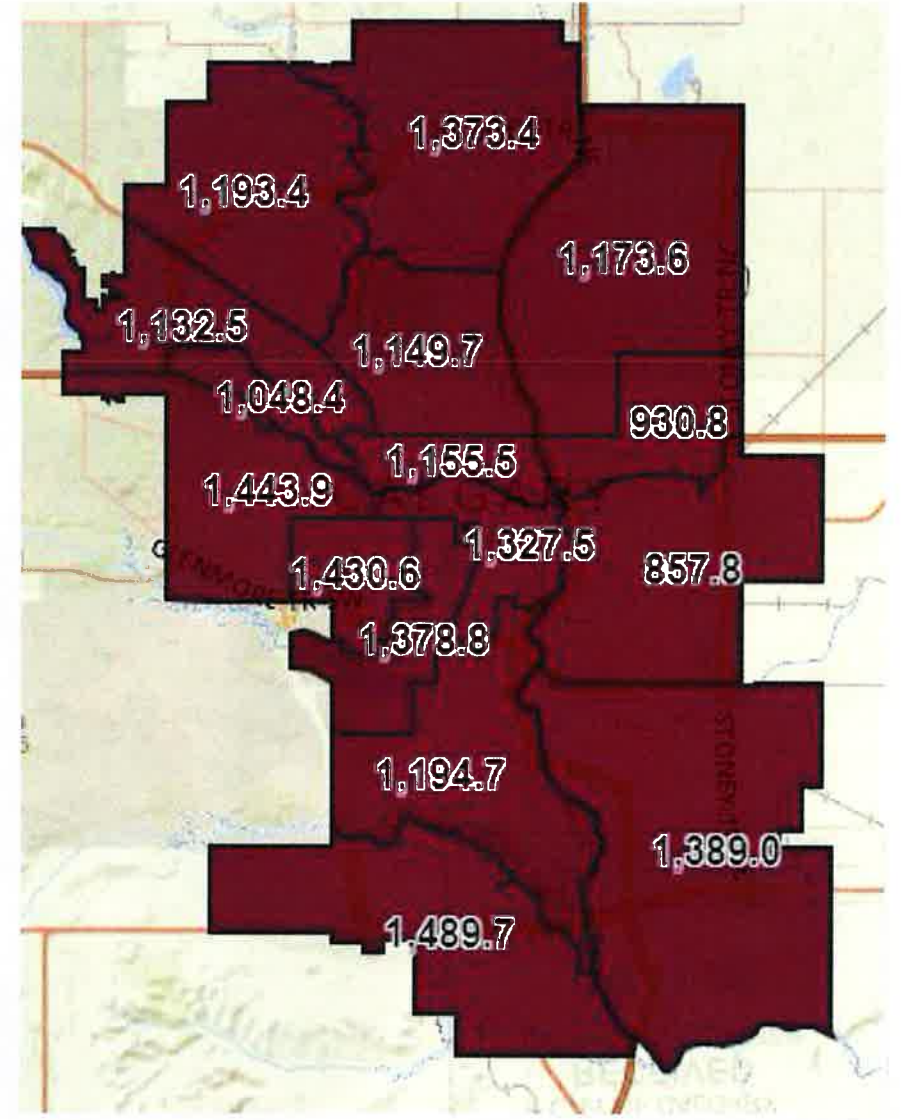

# COVID Update: Case Trends

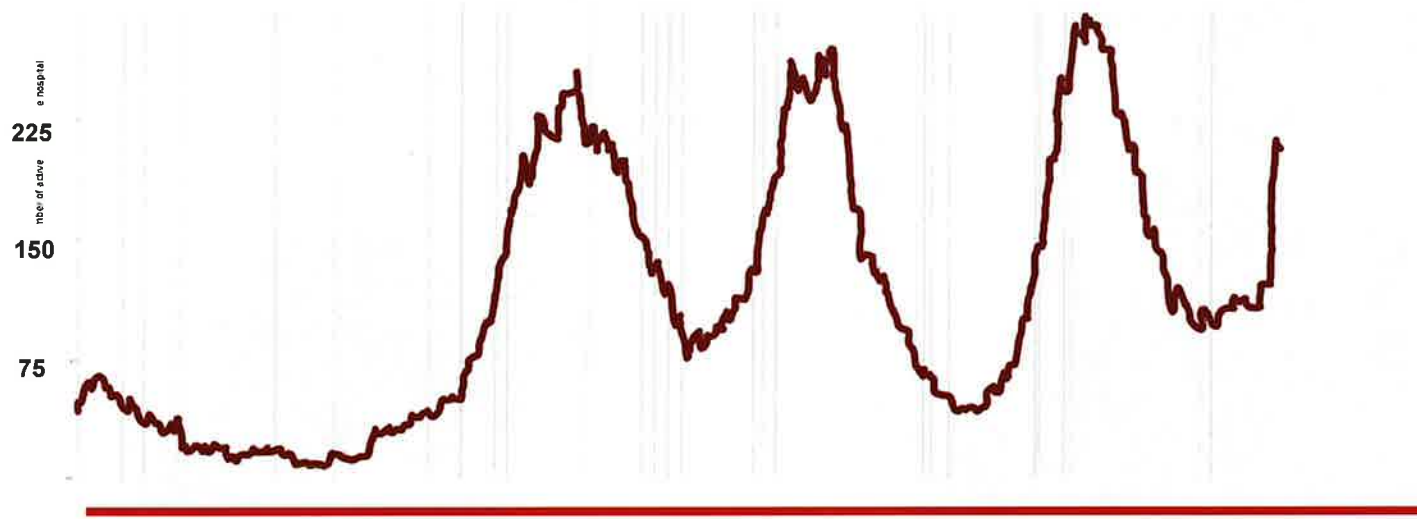
**Active Cases, Calgary Zone**



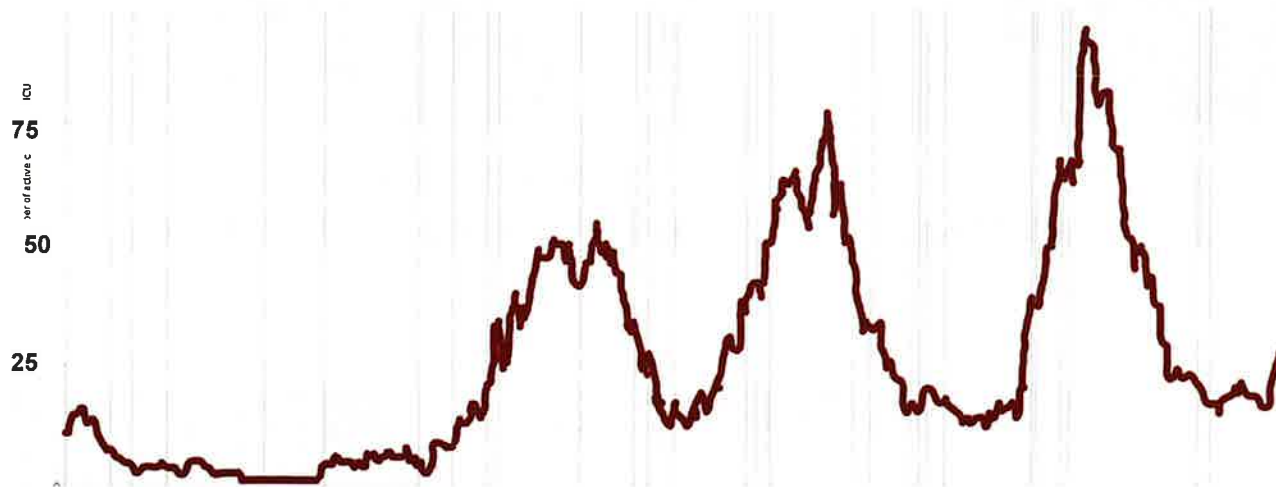
**Regional Indicator:  
Cases/100k Population**



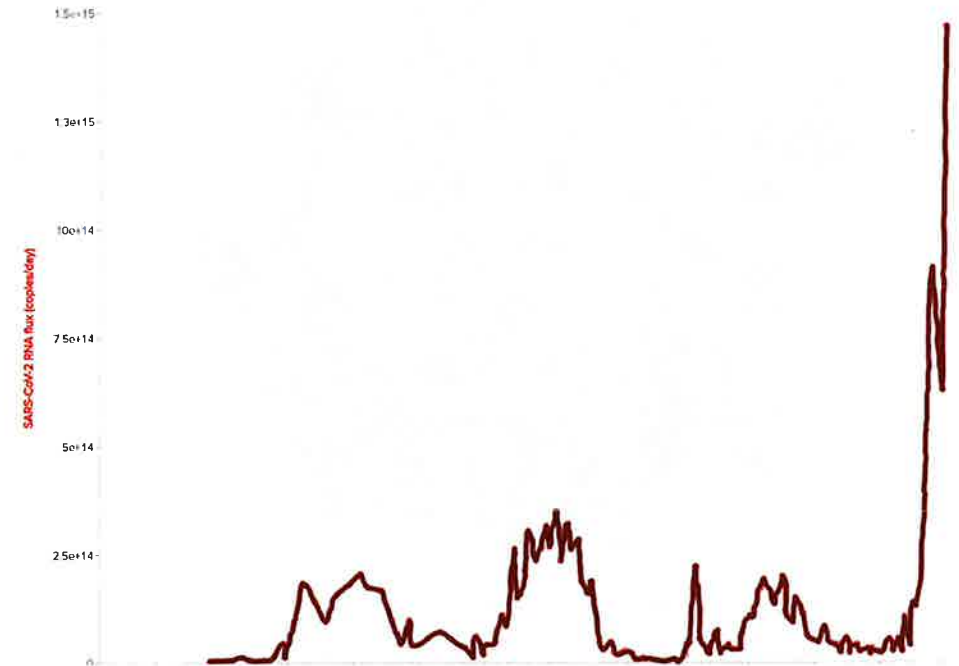
**Hospitalizations, Calgary Zone: 264**



**ICU Admissions, Calgary Zone: 28**



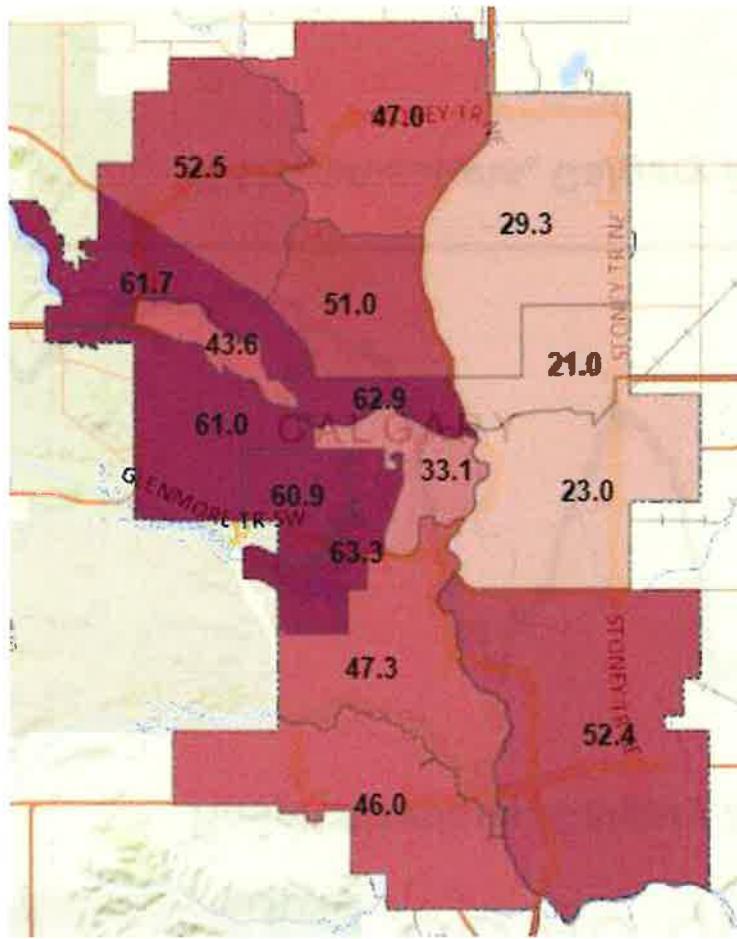
**Wastewater Sampling, Calgary Zone**



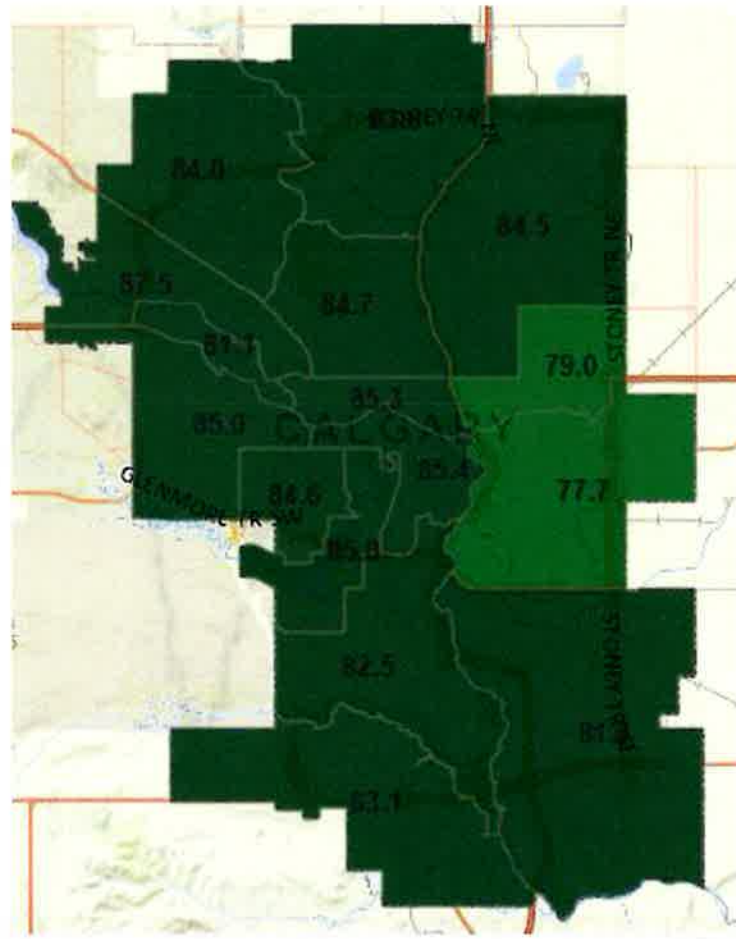

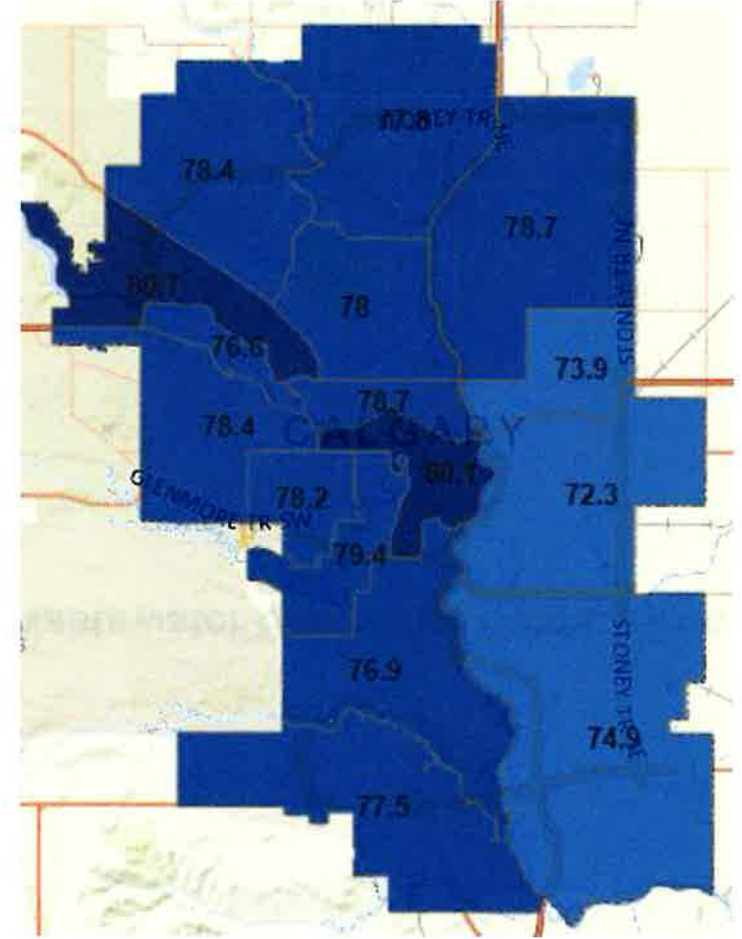
Percentage of Population 5-11 with First Dose

# Updates to Vaccine Passport Bylaw

- **Aligning to Restriction Exemption Program:**
  - *Eligible Business*
  - *Eligible Person*
  - *Personal Identification*
  - *Proof of Vaccination*
- **Differences Maintained:**
  - **Inability to ‘opt out’**
  - **No Exemption for Youth Sports**
