

## Proposed Amendment to Public Behaviour Bylaw

### Proposed Text of a Bylaw to amend Bylaw 54M2006, the Public Behaviour Bylaw

1. Bylaw 54M2006, the Public Behaviour Bylaw, is hereby amended.
2. In subsection 2(1), after subsection c) the following is added as subsection c.1):

“c.1) “harass” means to communicate with a person in a manner that could reasonably cause offence or humiliation, including conduct, comment, or actions that refers to the person’s race, religious beliefs, colour, disability, age, ancestry, place of origin, marital status, source of income, family status, gender, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation, and includes a sexual solicitation or advance;”.
3. The following is added after section 7 as section 7.1:

#### **“HARASSMENT**

7.1 No person shall harass another person in any public place.”.

4. In **SCHEDULE “A” – SPECIFIED PENALTIES**, under the headings indicated after:

<b>SECTION</b>	<b>OFFENCE</b>	<b>SPECIFIED PENALTY</b>
“7	Carry a visible knife in public	\$50.00”

the following is added:

<b>SECTION</b>	<b>OFFENCE</b>	<b>SPECIFIED PENALTY</b>
“7.1	Harassment	\$500.00”.

5. This Bylaw comes into force on June 1, 2022.
