


Business Improvement Areas 2022 Board Appointments & Mainstreet Bowness BIA Bylaw Amendment - CD2022-0027






Business Improvement Areas

- Calgary has 15 BIAs
- established by municipal bylaw under MGA
- operate as non-profit organizations
- 3 purposes (MGA)
- governed by boards of directors appointed by Council
- BIAs annually submit their nominees for appointment




BIA Board Appointments

- Board candidates nominated at each BIA's AGM
- Candidates meet legislative requirements
- Align with each BIA's board approved organizational bylaws







Mainstreet Bowness BIA

- Changing the number of board members requires the establishing bylaw be amended
- Proposing an increase in board size from 8 to 10 members

Recommendations

With respect to Report CD2022-0027, the following be approved:

- 4. Provide a letter to retiring board members to thank them for their service.
