## Moving People and their Possessions to Safety – An Overview

Address Criminal Activity • Calgary Police Service identifies violent offenders and lays charges.

Outreach

- Drop-In staff/outreach teams engage people on alternative housing options
- Drop-In staff work with clients to prepare plan for possessions

Security and Safety • Uniform services identify and address removal of safety hazards (weapons, flammables, biohazards, sharps)

Remove Structures • Encampment structures are disassembled and removed by City services

Ongoing Monitoring • Drop-In Centre, Calgary Police and Community Standards will coordinate ongoing monitoring and remove structures as soon as possible



## Recommendation

That the Community Development Committee:

- 1. Receive this information for the Corporate Record; and
- 2. Direct that the distribution titled Attachment 1 remain confidential pursuant to Sections 18 (disclosure harmful to individual or public safety) and 24 (Advice from officials) of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* to be reviewed by 2022 February 11; and
