Applicant Outreach Summary

Outreach Strategy

Following completion of the "Community Outreach Assessment" (as per the City's website), the resulting project impact score was identified as 1A. This score considers the application (Land Use Redesignation) to be a low impact to the community/not proposing a major change or disruption. As such, Stantec and Anthem chose to undertake the approach of informing existing residents of Belmont through online platforms including the Belmont Community Website (https://belmontcalgary.com/land-use-public-notice-2/) and Belmont Community Facebook page to provide additional information on the application and clarification of potential impacts to the community.

How did stakeholder input influence decisions?

Stakeholder input did not influence the decisions for this application. Since the application area is within an approved Outline Plan, for land use only, and is only proposed for future phases of Belmont (currently undeveloped); opportunities to adjust this particular application are limited with respect to alternative outcomes. Additionally, the outcomes of the Neighbourhood Node are not envisioned to change from what exists today as the application is simply addressing a minor boundary adjustment needed to facilitate design of the C-C1 commercial site. Should those engaged respond with any concerns or requests for additional clarification in understanding the impacts of the application, the applicant and/or file manager are committed to following up.
