BACKGROUND

The Legacy Parks Fund Steering Committee (LPFSC) oversees the ENMAX Legacy Parks Program Team to maximize the public investment and impact of the program by reviewing land acquisition opportunities, strategic program direction, project selection and expenditures within the ENMAX Legacy Parks Program and to provide recommendations to Council as required.

Current composition of the committee is six members, including two representatives from Parks Administration (non-voting). Members of the City Administration are appointed for one year terms, effective the date of the annual Organizational Meeting of Council. LPFSC's current member composition is contained in Attachment 1.
