Thank you for the opportunity to provide advice and comments on the update to The City of Calgary's Telecommunication Antenna Structures Siting Protocols. As per your request, we are providing our feedback in writing as outlined below.

The siting procedure should include:

- Submission requirements
- Public consultation
- Final concurrence or non-concurrence protocol

The LUA consultation process should also outline preferences and suggest alternative measures in regard to:

- Tower types
- Locations
- Criteria deemed desirable/undesirable

Moreover, ISED requires that proponents follow the consultation process established by the LUA unless the proposed antenna system meets the exclusion criteria, as outlined in Section 6 of CPC-2-0-03.
