BYLAW NUMBER 6B2015

BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF CALGARY TO REPEAL BYLAWS 16B2014 AND 17B2014

WHEREAS Council of The City of Calgary ("The City") is to approve Report C2015-0526 (Advancing Growth in Keystone Hills ASP: Borrowing Bylaws and Area Structure Plan Amendment);

AND WHEREAS Council duly passed Bylaws 16B2014 and 17B2014 on 2014 December 15 ("the Bylaws");

AND WHEREAS each of the Bylaws authorized The City to incur indebtedness in the amount of \$6.7 million to finance a capital program related to the construction of East & West Keystone utility infrastructure ("the Capital Program");

AND WHEREAS the indebtedness to finance the Capital Program is no longer required;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by Council to pass a bylaw pursuant to Section 191 of the <u>Municipal Government Act</u> (R.S.A. 2000 c. M-26) to repeal Bylaws 16B2014 and 17B2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALGARY, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Bylaws 16B2014 and 17B2014 are hereby repealed.

2. This Bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.
