Through various zoom meetings over the past sev- eral months, it has come to my understanding that this is to support extra parking for the church to help meet the parking bylaws in support of land acquired by the city for use of LRT parking. My concern is that this piece of land will be converted to a gravel parking lot which is between 2 residential homes, creating dust, noise and potential loi- ters hanging out there; will create safety concerns regarding extra traffic pulling out onto a street with busses and pedestrians walking along the south part of the road heading to and from the c-train. Another comment is that with these added parking spots (approx. 20-25), the church is still short parking to help them meet the bylaw requirements. This solution doesn't make sense in this regard. It also doesn't guaran- tee that this space will not be used for city buildings etc. Thank you for considering my concerns regarding this proposed land closure.
