### **Areas of Innovation**

- City's first pilot of planning culturally
- Academic research from three **Urban Alliance projects**
- Informed by the Chinatown Artist-in-Residency program
- Innovative engagement approach





### Recommendations

That the Executive Committee recommends that:

- 1. Council receive this report as information for the corporate record, fulfilling the reporting requirements for the Council Innovation Fund.
- 2. Council approve a one-time budget increase of \$250,000 in 2022 to the City Planning and Policy Service budget to be funded from the Fiscal Stability Reserve and Budget Savings Account Merged Reserve to accomplish project deliverables of the Tomorrow's Chinatown program; and
- 3. Administration report back through the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure & Planning on the three deliverables of Tomorrow's Chinatown, being: 1. Chinatown Cultural Plan 2: Chinatown Area Redevelopment Plan, and 3. Renaming of the James Short Park and Parkade, by no later than Q4, 2022.


