Harass:

to “*communicate with a person in a manner that could reasonably **cause offence or humiliation**, including conduct, **comment**, or **actions** that refers to the person’s **race, religious beliefs, colour, disability, age, ancestry, place of origin, marital status, source of income, family status, gender, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation**, and includes a **sexual solicitation or advance**.*”

Penalty/Fine: \$500

Effective Date: June 1, 2022
