### Administration Recommendation


That the Infrastructure and Planning Committee recommends that Council:


2. Direct Administration to report back after two years with operating impacts, a review of all fees, and the results of the committee relative to supporting applicants.

## **Lessons Learned**

Since 2019, Administration has supported three interim uses on LRT rights of way:

- 1. Community garden in Auburn Bay (GL)
- 2. Community plaza at 40 Avenue N (GL)
- 3. Pop up activation at Heritage LRT station (Red Line)
