2021 Snapshot

- 1.05 million visitors
- 77,000 active members
- 466 volunteers (43,500 hours), 250 FTE employees
- 91 summer camps hosted, welcoming 1,679 attendees
- 87% of waste was either recycled or composted
- Invested \$3.4M in conservation programs

Jane Goodall Act

- This Senate of Canada bill will establish strong legal protections for wild species kept in human care.
- Large coalition of animal welfare activists and Canadian AZA accredited ZOOS
- Transforms animal welfare
- Helps address animal trafficking
- Differentiates accredited zoos from other zoos and attractions
