1. METRICS AND TARGETS



Opportunity for the City to clearly communicate their expectations to stakeholders according to sector, and indicate how progress will be measured.

2. TRANSPARENCY

Facilitate information sharing to help stakeholders align their own climate risks and mitigation strategies with the City's Strategy, and with each other.

3. FINANCIAL SUPPORTS

Aggressively lead efforts to close the identified funding gap, facilitate pooling of resources and create the right incentive programs in partnership with industry, community and other levels of government.

Work with utility companies and industries to assure equitable access and pricing for consumers.

4. FACILITATION AND ENGAGEMENT

The City to function as a catalyst and platform for formal and informal collaboration across all groups.

Business, industry, institutional and community groups need a reliable platform to develop and sustain collaborative initiatives.

5. POLICY AND ADVOCACY

Align processes and approvals across jurisdictions and departments. Work with other levels of government and technical standard groups to ensure policy is present to support change efforts (e.g. energy transition policy and water re-use for adaptation policies).
