- Own a house on a lot that could allow 6 story buildings
- Rosedale and Renfrew are both amazing inner-city communities
- My issue is with the plan and it's lack of consistency
- I am not wishing what's proposed for Renfrew on Rosedale, quite the opposite
- This plan amplifies disparities between communities and that's a problem
- Comparisons between communities are only intended to show the flaws in the plan
- The plan needs to be rethought because goals are not met

Stated Goals Not Achieved

Goals For Great Communities

- 1. Promote housing options that are varied, inclusive and affordable.
- **2.** Provide opportunities to access goods, services and amenities close by.
- **3.** Offer opportunities to gather and participate in civic, arts, cultural and entertainment activities, in both public and private spaces.
- Provide varied and inclusive spaces and facilities for recreation, play and outdoor activities close by.

- **5.** Provide spaces that foster a sense of place and are designed for everyone.
- **6.** Ensure natural areas, biodiversity and ecological functions are protected, restored and enjoyed.
- **7.** Enable and support prosperity through diverse economic opportunities at a variety of scales.
- **8.** Support the use of existing streets, services and buildings to reduce the need for new infrastructure.
- The very first goal from the Guidebook is not met
- Inclusivity is not achieved and greater disparity is created

Renfrew Inclusivity Today

- Renfrew appears pretty inclusive already!
- According to data from the City of Calgary Community Profiles:

Why So Aggressive?



- Renfrew already has housing options that are varied, inclusive and affordable
- The red areas could permit 6 story buildings where 1-2 story houses now reside
- Why is Renfrew being allowed to be erased and rebuilt while Rosedale is protected?
- This will undoubtedly **create more disparity** between communities!

Flawed Plan



- ► The Guidebook goals are easily understood
- Somehow the North Hill Communities Local Area Plan missed the point
- ► This plan amplifies differences between communities
- Fails to meet the first stated goal!
- ▶ Will lead to greater inequity and it needs to be rethought

- Information from the City regarding the March 22nd date for the North Hill Communities Local Area Plan was misleading and may have impacted public participation. This is part of a pattern of poor communication.
- ► The City website stated:

 - ▶ Okay... one decision so just the Guidebook right??

 - Coming up on March 22, Council will deliberate on the Guidebook for Great Communities for Everyone....
 - Renfrew and Fairview will be the first Ward 9 Communities to get forward-looking Local Area Plans.... Both are slated for Council before the summer break.
 - ▶ The above is technically true, but IS COMPLETELY MISLEADING
 - ▶ If Councilors don't know what's going on, how can the public?
