NOTICE OF MOTION

**ELBOW VALLEY WEST SERVICING
COUNCILLOR KEATING**

WHEREAS The City of Calgary has an established policy (OE92-31) to limit the provision of utility servicing to developments outside of its boundaries, without the prior approval of City Council;

AND WHEREAS The City's policy recognizes that it may be in The City's overall interest, for environmental reasons, to make available City services to rural development in certain circumstances;

AND WHEREAS The City of Calgary has previously approved the extension of The City's sanitary sewer servicing – for environmental reasons - into the Elbow Valley area laying west of The City and within Rocky View County, including Pinebrook, Elbow Valley, Stonepine, Country Haven Estates and the Glencoe and Elbow Valley golf courses;

AND WHEREAS approximately 31 million litres of raw sewage are transported from "pump and haul" tanks in Elbow Valley West across the Glenmore causeway to The City's Bonnybrook Sewage Treatment plant each year;

AND WHEREAS City Council on 2010 July 29 referred a previous motion on this matter to Administration to be considered with the implementation of the regional servicing strategy;

AND WHEREAS Rocky View County has not yet agreed to participate in the voluntary Calgary Regional Partnership / Calgary Metropolitan Plan, and is unlikely to alter its position on joining;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that City Council:

1. Allow this connection notwithstanding that Rocky View County is not a member of the Calgary Regional Partnership;
2. Allow this connection as an "environmental exception" to Policy OE92-31;
3. Reaffirm its commitment to not extend servicing beyond its boundaries without specific authorization from City Council;
4. Direct City Administration to negotiate and execute a servicing agreement with Rocky View County to accept additional wastewater through the Elbow Valley sewer trunk from Elbow Valley West, to a maximum of 121 homes.
