## **BYLAW NUMBER 5B2015**

## BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF CALGARY TO AMEND VARIOUS BYLAWS BY REDUCING SURPLUS BORROWING AUTHORITY IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$73,949,181

WHEREAS Council of The City of Calgary ("Council") duly passed the borrowing bylaws described in the attached Schedule "A" ("the Borrowing Bylaws"); AND WHEREAS the Borrowing Bylaws did authorize The City of Calgary to issue debentures to a total amount of \$88,877,577 to finance certain capital programs ("the Capital Programs"), although debentures totalling only \$14,928,396 have been issued against the Borrowing Bylaws; AND WHEREAS the surplus borrowing authority for the Capital Programs is no longer required; AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by Council to pass a bylaw pursuant to Section 191 of the Municipal Government Act (R.S.A. 2000 c. M-26) to amend the Roprowing Bylaws by reducing surplus borrowing authority in the total amount of \$73,949,181. NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALGARY, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS: Each of the Borrowing Bylaws described in the attached Schedule "A" is hereby 1. amended by reducing the balance of borrowing authority in the amount listed in the said Schedule, for a total reduction of \$73,940,181.
