

## **Previous Council Direction**

Previous Council direction includes <u>Notice of Motion (NoM) PFC2021-1365</u> "Prioritizing School Routes in the 5A Network" from September 13, 2021. In this NoM, Council directed Administration to do two things:

- 1. Report back to Council in November 2021 on a framework for working with key stakeholders such as schools, JUCC, community organizations, City business units and provincial organizations to identify and prioritize capital improvements to achieve the 5A Network Guiding Principles.
- 2. Report back to Council in June 2022 with opportunities to expand the program by increase the area of study around schools, identifying priority routes/schools, and additional funding for infrastructure improvements.

In November 2021, Administration reported back to Council (C2021-1448) on the existing ASRS program, stakeholder collaboration, and use of existing capital funding for infrastructure improvements. The information was received and recommendation of reporting back to council through the Infrastructure and Planning Committee no later than Q2 2022 with operational and capital funding recommendations for an expanded Active and Safe Routes to School Program was carried.
