Previous Council Direction, Background

Context

The industrial sector is a crucial pillar of Calgary's economy. From the competitive advantage in multimodal logistics and distribution provided by the Calgary International Airport, to emerging waste diversion-and reduction businesses, Calgary's industrial sector plays an important role in supporting a resilient, diversified, and prosperous economy.

On 2021 March 22, Council directed Administration to take clear actions to support the industrial sector by approving the Industrial Action Plan as part of the Citywide Growth Strategy: Industrial (PUD2021-0150). With this work, specific actions were directed to streamline the Land Use Bylaw by prioritizing the review and update of industrial districts of the Land Use Bylaw (Action A.1), as well as to update and strengthen industrial policies in the Municipal Development Plan to reinforce that industrial uses remain the primary uses within industrial areas (Action A.2).
