# What is a Joint Use and Planning Agreement

- **Framework** for collaborations
- **Processes** for planning, development and maintenance of joint use sites
- **Use** of school facilities, municipal facilities and playing fields
- **Reserve Fund** to purchase school sites and open space
- **Transfer and disposition** of reserve and non-reserve lands

# What has changed?

- **Role of school sites** in creating complete communities;
- Reflect current **policy and planning** practices;
- Potential for **multiple uses** on joint use sites;
- Maintenance and operational **responsibilities**;
- Update the use of the **reserve fund**; and
- Modernize disposal of **surplus school sites**.
