Creating a Multi-Season Gathering Space



A permanent hard surface court will anchor the site to support a rink in the winter and ball sports in the spring, summer and fall. We can also host markets and other activities on the court.



A central location to host community enrichment events such as the RISE UP musical performances and CalgaryEATS! Farm Stand Program.



Activities bring together neighbours and help build a more vibrant community. We can host activities such as Movie in the Park, Zumba in the Park and more.



Creating Sustainability in the Community



Volunteers learning to use the new RinkWater System on the Adopt A Rink. A permanent hard court will allow us to use less water.



A natural playground will bring kids closer to nature, reuse organic materials and create a low maintenance place for children to explore. This is planned as Phase III of the overall project.



A community garden allows residents to grow food and create a micro-climate for insects and birds. This is Phase I of the project. Building completion expected Summer 2022.



Recommendations
