Planning & Development Deferral to Infrastructure and Planning Committee 2022 July 07

Deferral Request – North Hill Communities Heritage Guidelines due Q3 2022 to Q4 2022

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Infrastructure and Planning Committee recommend that Council defer the North Hill Communities Heritage Guidelines report due Q3 2022, to return by end of Q4 2022.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE AND PLANNING COMMITTEE, 2022 JULY 07:

That Council defer the North Hill Communities Heritage Guidelines report due Q3 2022, to return by end of Q4 2022.

Rationale:

Administration requires additional time to finalize the policy amendments to the North Hill Communities Local Area Plan (LAP) and complete community outreach prior to reporting back to Council for the North Hill Communities Heritage Guidelines project. Administration completed the final session with the project's multi-stakeholder working group in early June. The group identified desired refinements to the heritage guidelines. Many community stakeholders, including community associations, do not meet in the summer months; therefore, Administration will continue to make the requested refinements and then share those with stakeholders and the public in early September 2022. The revised timeline will allow stakeholders time following the summer break to review the final heritage guidelines. Administration will also share the Council-directed revisions to Section 1.3 *Community Characteristics* of the North Hill Communities LAP with stakeholders in September 2022.

Background:

At the 2021 April 12 Combined Meeting of Council, through a Motion Arising, Council directed Administration "as part of developing the heritage guidelines for the North Hill Communities Local Area Plan, to include sub-headings in Section 1.3 *Community Characteristics* that details the history, evolution, and unique characteristics of each of the nine communities and return to Council no later than Q3 2022."
