Where City employees serve as directors, they must act in the best interest of the organization, even if that is in conflict with their view of the best interest of The City. While the likelihood and impact of such risk occurring is being mitigated over time given that, in accordance with the Civic Partner Accountability Framework, Council has reduced the number of City employees appointed to such Boards, this risk to The City and its employees remains in situations where City employees continue to be so appointed."
