BYLAW NUMBER 26M2022

BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF CALGARY TO TRANSFER ENVIRONMENTAL RESERVE TO THE CROWN

WHEREAS The City of Calgary has agreed to transfer the environmental reserve, as identified below, to the Crown for the completion of the Deerfoot Trail improvements and interchange expansion;

WHEREAS the provisions of sections 676(1) and 676(1)(b) of the <u>Municipal Government</u> <u>Act</u>, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 as amended, with respect to the disposition of environmental reserve have been complied with, and

AND WHEREAS the provisions of Sections 216.4 and 606 of the <u>Municipal Government</u> <u>Act</u>, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 as amended, with respect to notice of intention of Council to pass such a Bylaw have been complied with;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALGARY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 Upon passage of the Bylaw, transfer documents shall be submitted to the Alberta Land Titles Office and the following described environmental reserve parcel shall be cancelled and the registrar shall transfer ownership to the Crown and issue any new certificate of title as required:

Plan 7911222 Block 10ER (Environmental Reserve) Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

Comprising of 3.040 hectares (7.51 acres), more or less, shown on the Schedule "A" site map.

Municipally known as 1325 DEERFOOT TR SE

2. The proper officers of The City of Calgary are hereby authorized to execute such instruments as may be necessary to effect the purpose of the Bylaw.
