
Recommendations


Heritage Area Policy Tools





North Hill Communities Local Area Plan

- Sets out the vision and policies for growth and change in the North Hill Communities.
- Includes interim policies to guide development of the heritage guidelines and direct implementation through land use bylaw amendments.
- Proposed policy amendments will replace the interim policies and update Map 5: Heritage Guideline Areas



Map 5: Heritage Guideline Areas






Heritage Guidelines

Highlights

- Guide new development within identified Heritage Guideline Areas in the North Hill Communities.
- Ensure that new development is contextually sensitive and fits into the historic context.
- Encourage new development to draw design reference from nearby heritage assets.
- Include Land Use Bylaw amendments within the Heritage Guideline Areas to facilitate implementation (discretionary uses).





Heritage Guidelines

The guidelines DO:

Address general characteristics of new buildings.

 Reference key design elements of existing heritage assets in the North Hill Communities.

The guidelines DO NOT:

 Prescribe historic architectural styles for new development. Contemporary designs are encouraged.

Limit the number of dwelling units or housing type.


