12CSI is a crime prevention collaborative that works within the 12 communities of CPS District 4 which takes in the above address.

We have three major goals:

- 1. Increase compliance with criminal laws and city bylaws (in other words, a decrease in social disorder);
- 2. Improve image and enhance pride;
- 3. Increase involvement, awareness of issues and inclusion.

It is important that we begin to change the <u>character of the area to help improve the image</u>. 17th Avenue SE has a proliferation of liquor stores, pawnshops, cash stops and bars. It is the cumulative effect that produces a negative image.

The 17th Avenue Corridor Study, which has been passed by Council, recognizes that <u>the character needs to change</u> to enhance the vibrancy and livability of the area.

12CSI is using a variety of strategies to encourage compliance with laws and bylaws. It is an uphill battle in this area due to the accumulation of "negative" uses. Together they are a problem and crime-mapping stats clearly show that <u>social disorder is a major issue</u> for both police and bylaws.

We are also trying to involve the local community. It is applications like this that cause people to think – why bother?! We need good stories to tell.

This application is so similar to a previous application, 12CSI wonders why it was accepted again.
