2022 Grey Cup and 2023 Quebec Carnival Council Representatives

PURPOSE OF BRIEFING

This briefing provides information about the selection of Council's representatives to attend the 2022 Grey Cup and the 2023 Quebec Carnival.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

The Councillors' Budgets and Expenses Bylaw ("the Bylaw") provides that Councillors may attend the Grey Cup and Quebec Carnival. Historically, two Councillors have been selected to attend each event.

The Bylaw allows:

- For the Grey Cup (2022 November 20, Regina) - up to five nights of accommodation. The Bylaw's allowance for out of town travel costs does not include a ticket to the game and, if such a ticket is purchased, it cannot be charged to The City.
- For the Quebec Carnival (2023 February 3-12, Quebec City) - up to four nights of accommodation.

Effective 2021, the selection of Council Representatives to attend these events is conducted by the City Clerk's Office by random draw from amongst Councillors who express interest in attending.

The Representatives for the 2023 Quebec Carnival are as follows:

2. Councillor Penner

After an initial request for expression of interest to attend the 2022 Grey Cup, two Councillors were selected. One of the Councillors subsequently withdrew their expression of interest.
