




Subject Site: Infill/Final Development Phase

### **Buildout and Approved Land Uses**





- Silverado buildout is mainly as low density residential (yellow, purple estate area)
- North Silverado approved mainly for multi-residential (yellow, orange areas)

### Approved Plan (2018)





#### Concerns of the Community in 2018 included:

- Excessive Density
- High traffic volumes
- Parking issues
- Over provision of multi-residential
- Poor interface with existing residences
- Lack of a playground
- Construction traffic
- Inconsistency with existing community character

#### Proposed Land Use Plan






### 2021: Apex provided an offer to purchase and submitted a new plan to the City of Calgary
