Combined	4/12/2022	Land Use Amendment in Mount Pleasant (Ward 7), LOC2021-0137 CPC2022-0256	That with respect to Report CPC2022-0256, the following Motion Arising be adopted: That Council direct Administration to minimize the number of Direct Control districts proposed for planning applications where R-CG does not fully serve the needs of the applicant and the community by bringing an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to create a new land use district that addresses the shortcomings of the R-CG district in creating the missing middle, reporting back to Council through the Infrastructure and Planning Committee no later than end of Q3 2022.
Combined	5/10/2022	Tax Relief Options for Residential Properties Impacted by Annexation Order 333/2007 EC2022-0504	That with respect to Report EC2022-0504, the following be adopted: That Council: Cancel 75% of the municipal tax differential for the residential portion of eligible properties based on the criteria specified in Attachment 5 for 2022; Direct Administration to report back to Council through the Executive Committee in Q2 2023 for Council to consider cancelling 50% of the municipal tax differential for the residential portion of eligible properties based on the criteria specified in Attachment 5 for 2023; and Direct Administration to report back to Council through the Executive Committee in Q2 2024 for Council to consider cancelling 25% of the municipal tax differential for the residential portion of eligible properties based on the criteria specified in Attachment 5 for 2024.
Combined	5/10/2022	Parking Management Zone Change - Bridgeland IP2022-0392	That with respect to Report IP2022-0392, the following Motion Arising be adopted: That Council direct Administration to bring back an update to the Calgary Parking Policies to streamline the process for changes to the paid parking zones and return to Council through the Infrastructure and Planning Committee no later than Q4 2022.



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Combined	5/10/2022	Regulated Taxi Meter Rate Adjustment CD2022-0528	That with respect to Report CD2022-0528, the following Motion Arising be adopted: That Council direct Administration to report back with a plan of how Livery Transport Services will support The City of Calgary's goal of reaching net-zero by 2050, including: An assessment on reducing the daily number of vehicles that rely on the move circuits for fares no later than Q1 2023; An understanding of the number of TNC licenses versus taxi licenses to create a competitive balance and an equitable environment in the livery market; and A plan whether to add more city-wide taxi stands by Q3 2022.
Combined	6/7/2022	Notice of Motion - Developing Municipal Event and Landmark Policy Areas EC2022-0662	Approve one-time funding of up to \$200,000 for multi-community engagement, event operations enhancements (such as increased communication practices), temporary event infrastructure supports and required staffing from the Economic Development and Policy Coordination (EDPC) budget, and to report back through the Community Development Committee with an implementation plan no later than September 2022; and Direct Administration to incorporate a request for resources with a funding strategy through the Eventful City Strategy, to support the implementation and continued work, and report back to Council through the 2023-2026 Service Plans and Budgets process in November 2022.
Combined	6/7/2022	Problem Properties: Vehicle Enforcement CD2022-0469	That with respect to Report CD2022-0469, the following Motion Arising be adopted: That Council direct Administration to: Review Calgary's existing regulations, including the definition(s) of recreational vehicle; Conduct a jurisdictional scan of municipalities in Canada to review best practices for parking and use of recreational vehicles on private residential property; Engage citizens and other key stakeholders to solicit feedback regarding parking of recreational vehicles on private residential property; and Report back to Council through the Community Development Committee no later than 2023 Q2.



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Combined	6/7/2022	Notice of Motion - Housing and Affordability Task Force EC2022-0638	That with respect to Notice of Motion EC2022-0638, the following be adopted: NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That Council direct Administration to: Return to Council during the 2023-2026 budget discussions with a workplan and budget request to support the work for a report to Council by 2023 Q3 considering: The development of a Housing and Affordability Task Force, that would report to Council with advice and policy recommendations relating to increasing, measuring, and managing Housing Affordability and Affordable Housing along the entire housing continuum, including a survey/review of existing programs, policies, and solutions both locally and in other relevant jurisdictions; An exploration of models for the creation of a Housing Security Commission to work in collaboration with The City, supportive housing providers, non-market housing providers, Calgary Housing Company, attainable homeownership providers, emergency shelters, the provincial and federal governments, to increase equitable outcomes for Calgarians seeking safe, affordable, and supportive housing; and Address these considerations as a part of the refreshed Corporate Affordable Housing Strategy. Report back to Council by 2023 Q1 with: A review of all City-owned parcels to ensure broad consideration for the Non-Market Land Sale, and modification of relevant corporate policies and practices, including the Non-Market Land Sale Policy, to ensure The City can capitalize on and leverage the Federal 2022 Budget commitments to Housing; and to better position The City to support the creation of more Affordable Housing; and Strategies to support non-profit and private sector efforts to better leverage the National Housing Strategy/Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation affordable housing and missing middle programs.
