Highlights:

- On 2022 September 6, a Band Council Resolution was passed by Tsuut'ina Nation
- Band Council Resolution received by Mayor's Office 2022 October 28
- Circulated to Council 2022 November 3



Content

- The City of Calgary has a history of receiving service requests from neighbouring municipalities and Tsuut'ina Nation.
- The City already provides some water and wastewater servicing to Tsuut'ina nation through a Master Servicing Agreement.
- The City of Calgary evaluated a similar request of Calgary Transit service from the City of Chestermere in 2018. This request resulted in the extension of the Max Purple to Chestermere in 2021.

Recommendation:

That the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee recommend Council direct Administration to begin discussions with Tsuut'ina Public Works and Taza Development Corporation about exploring the possibility of transit service between Calgary and Tsuut'ina Nation and report back to Council through the Intergovernmental Affairs Committee with an update no later than Q4 2023.
