The primary function of the eGovernment Strategy Advisory Committee is to monitor and guide the overall vision, strategy and program for eGovernment at The City of Calgary. The roles and responsibilities of the eGovernment Strategy Advisory Committee include:

- Review key strategies, associated performance measures and benchmarks;
- Provide guidance and advice on advancing the key strategy area outcomes;
- Review program plan;
- Represent a broader stakeholder community including partnership opportunities;
- Champion The City's eGovernment Strategy; and
- Provide a status report as required to the SPC on Utilities and Corporate Service.

As per the eGovernment Strategy Advisory Committee Terms of Reference, membership includes three members representing the technical or communications industry and four members representing community organizations with an interest in eGovernment. Members are appointed at the annual Organizational Meeting of Council for a two-year term. The eGovernment Strategy Advisory Committee's current membership and quorum is detailed in Attachment 1.

INVESTIGATION: ALTERNATIVES AND ANALYSIS

On 2014 October 28, Anil Iqbal notified the City Clerk's Office that he is unable to accept Council's appointment to the eGovernment Strategy Advisory Committee (Attachment 2).

Council may wish to appoint a new member representing the technical or communications industry in order to fill the vacancy created by the resignation. For Council's consideration, this report brings forward applicants who expressed an interest in serving on the eGovernment Strategy Advisory Committee during the 2014/2015 Board, Commission and Committee recruitment campaign (Attachment 3).

Stakeholder Engagement, Research and Communication

On 2014 November 18, the City Clerk's Office contacted eligible applicants, who did not receive an appointment to a Board, Commission or Committee during the 2014 Organizational Meeting of Council, to confirm their continued interest in the eGovernment Strategy Advisory Committee. Only those applicants who expressed a continued interest in serving on the eGovernment Strategy Advisory Committee are provided in Attachment 3.
