PREVIOUS COUNCIL DIRECTION / POLICY

At the 2014 October 20 Organizational Meeting of Council, Council appointed Councillor Demong to serve on the IMC – Foothills for a term to expire at the 2015 Organizational Meeting of Council.

BACKGROUND

The purpose of the IMC – Foothills is to facilitate the working relationship between the MD of Foothills and The City of Calgary, the ongoing sharing of information between elected officials and municipal staff and to provide a forum in which to review and comment on a range of topics of interest to both municipalities.

INTER-MUNICIPAL COMMITTEE FOOTHILLS - APPOINTMENT

In accordance with the IMC – Foothills Terms of Reference, up to a maximum of three elected members of each municipality should be appointed to the Committee by each of the two Councils. Only elected representatives of the MD of Foothills and The City of Calgary are considered to be Committee members. The IMC – Foothills' composition and quorum is detailed in Attachment 1.

The IMC – Foothills holds a minimum of four regularly scheduled meetings per year, typically alternating the meeting location between the MD of Foothills and The City of Calgary. Either municipality may request an additional meeting to discuss pressing matters. The next scheduled meeting of the IMC – Foothills is on 2015 January 30 in The City of Calgary.

INVESTIGATION: ALTERNATIVES AND ANALYSIS

On 2014 November 26, the City Clerk's Office received an expression of interest from Councillor Keating to serve on the IMC – Foothills (Attachment 2). As the IMC – Foothills Terms of Reference provide that membership may include up to three elected members of each municipality, Council may wish to appoint a second elected representative of The City of Calgary.

Stakeholder Engagement, Research and Communication

The IMC – Foothills Terms of Reference were reviewed in the preparation of this report.
