BACKGROUND

 Council adopted the following policy to enable them to discern previous organizational affiliation when making volunteer citizen committee appointments.

PURPOSE

2. To provide Council with complete information when making citizen member decisions, and to provide clear wording in the advertisement for citizen member applications for Council's committees.


POLICY

- 3. The advertisement for citizens applying for volunteer member positions on Council committees must include the following:
 - Your reason for applying and should also include status for eligibility qualifications;
 - 3.2 You must advise of any previous involvement with, employment affiliation and/or proceeding against the Organization you are applying for;
 - 3.3 A resume of no more than two 8.5" x 11" pages should be attached, stating background and experience; and
 - 3.4 Up to a maximum of three committees may be applied for, however, citizen representatives shall serve on only one committee.
