- 2017 Council decision: MNAR3 Policy Implementation Guide
- Other current projects will not be affected

2017 Indigenous Policy

- 1) Lacked inclusion
- 2) Contained misinformation on the history of the Métis in Calgary

The Guide

1) Is intended to clarify cultural protocols and identify projects





The Environment: Métis Nation of Alberta and the Societies Act

- Provincial Societies Act
- Historic barrier: inherent right to Métis self-government under S.35
- 2019 Métis Government Recognition & Self-Government Agreement
- Move to federal recognition





The Environment: Métis Nation of Alberta and the Otipemisiwak Métis government constitution

- Constitution commission
- Approval of draft
- November vote
- Realignment Q4 2023


