- Provincial Societies Act
- Historic barrier: inherent right to Métis self-government under S.35
- 2019 Métis Government Recognition & Self-Government Agreement
- Move to federal recognition

- Constitution commission
- Approval of draft
- November vote

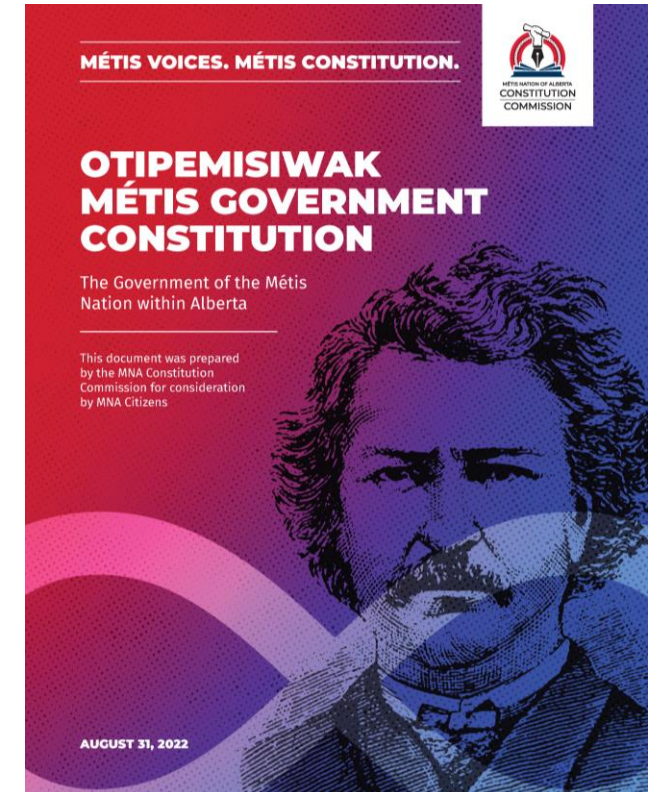
