Project Summary

The Foothills Athletic Park Redevelopment Assessment Committee was formed in 2019 to:

- 1. Assess redevelopment potential for lands at Foothills Athletic Park;
- 2. Pursue options for a funding framework and partnership opportunities for the future Fieldhouse facility.

In 2021 the Foothills + McMahon Concept Plan was presented to the Foothills Athletic Park Redevelopment Advisory Committee and Council.

Shift auto-oriented focus to urban centre that maximizes walking, biking and transit



Develop porous blocks that connect to the existing urban fabric



Improve transit connections through placemaking



Create a year-round sports, recreation and entertainment village



Establish a flexible and implementable vision




Enable strategic phasing













Social Return on Investment Analysis



- In 2021, the Committee directed Administration to undertake a Social Return on Investment (SROI) Analysis.
- Analysis was based on the 2021 Concept Plan and included a literature review to identify SROI for the proposed amenity mix.
- Results indicate high social returns, particularly linked to public access recreation, health and wellness and housing.



Next Steps

- 1. Establish new committee Feb 14, 2023 Regular Meeting of Council
- 2. Continue funding advocacy efforts
- 3. Complete Amenity Refinement Study
